Privacy Notice

This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for www.brandelmurphyfoundation.org. This privacy notice applies solely to information collected by this website. It will serve to notify you of the following:

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to/collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request, e.g. to ship an order.

Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via email in the future to tell you more about the Foundation, our efforts, opportunities to support us in the future as well as to notify you regarding any changes to this privacy policy.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from us at any time. You can do this at any time by contacting us via the email address, contact form, or phone number given on our website. You can also use this format to:

- See what data we have about you, if any.
- Change/correct any data we have about you.
- Have us delete any data we have about you.
- Express any concern you have about our use of your data.

Security

We take precautions to protect your personal information. When you submit any sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a lock icon in the address bar and looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the Web page.

We may request information from you on our donation and order forms where you must provide contact information (like name and shipping/billing address) and financial information (like credit card number, expiration date). This information is used only for billing purposes and to process your donation or fill your orders. If we have trouble processing an order, we'll use this information to contact you.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect you offline because we do not share your information with anyone.

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on a site visitor's hard drive to help us improve your access to our site and identify repeat visitors to our site. For instance, when a site uses a cookie to identify you, you would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Cookies can also

enable a site to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our site. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information on our site.
