Subject: Veterans Committee Report January 2019

The Poughkeepsie Veterans Committee recently completed our Homeless Veterans "Care Bag" project. The committee secured a \$3,500.00 ENF Grant to purchases needed items for 50 "Care Bags" for local Poughkeepsie Homeless Veterans. To complete this project we partnered with The MHA of Dutchess County Vet2Vet Peer Services, whose director is Lodge member Adam Roche. They have established a relationship with homeless Veterans living on the streets of Poughkeepsie, and meet with them every Friday Night. Adam provided a list of necessities to go into the care bags. Each bags contains: Tooth brush and tooth paste, hand sanitizer, wet wipes, deodorant, instant breakfast drink, energy bars, beef jerky, grab and go ready to eat meal kit, insulated hat, insulated gloves, thermal socks, thermal shirt, and hand warmers. We ordered weather resistant draw string bags/back packs to hold all the supplies. Once the items arrived at the Lodge, the committee got together and assembled all 50 bag in assembly line manor. The bags were then turned over to Adam and the Vet2Vets Peer Services to distribute to the Homeless Veterans right here in the City of Poughkeepsie.
