## Job Description: Behavior Technician

The specific role of the Behavior Technician is to provide intervention, teaching, and support to children and/or young adults under their care. Behavior Technicians provide 1:1 behavior intervention to children and/or young adults and report directly to a Lead Therapist and BCBA. Behavior Technicians are responsible for implementing the specific ABA programs as written by the BCBA.

Behavioral Specialists of Louisiana utilizes multiple ABA-based teaching strategies such as Discrete Trial Training, PRT, PECS and other play-based ABA techniques. Behavior Technicians will be trained to reliably implement these strategies and are required to collect data during every session.

## Job Duties and Responsibilities

Behavior Technicians will regularly perform the following duties:

- Complete orientation and ongoing training
- Collect data electronically
- Provide teaching programs and reinforcement to people in their care
- Assist with activities of daily living for people in their care
- Work with supervisory staff for ongoing program modification
- Complete weekly supervision

- Minimum of six month's experience working with children, adolescents, or young adults (preference special needs)
- Ability to independently and repeatedly lift, move, and carry objects weighing a minimum of thirtyfive (35) pounds
