COUNCIL MEETING

November 5, 2020

Public hearing was called to order by Mayor Patrick Edwards at 7:00p.m.. Roll call: Cathi Fouts, Chris Wood, John Bartello, Chris Norman and Cindy Humke. Absent: no one. Fouts moved and was seconded by Humke to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- a. Jordan Hostetler has submitted application #3 for final payment to Manatt's. Humke made motion to approve pay application #3. Bartello 2nd the motion. 5 ayes 0 nayes. Check was signed at Council meeting and will be mailed out the next day. This will be the final payment to Manatt's due to completion of project. Release of Claims was also signed and will be on file with City Clerk.
- b. Norman made motion to amend agenda to include guest Ed Philbin and his request for a building permit. Bartello 2nd. The motion to amend agenda was carried 5-0. Wood made motion to approve Ed Philbin's request for building permit for an add-on to his garage. Norman 2nd the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- c. Annual Finance Report for FY 2020 was not finished at time of meeting due to web site needed to complete report being down. AFR will be completed by Andreas and emailed to Council for approval before filing it with State.
- d. Lambs Grove has received quotes from Jasper Construction to repair a manhole cover sleeve on Tonca Trail and a storm drain on Emerson Hough that were damaged during the Derecho. Bartello made motion to approve quotes. Wood 2nd motion. Motion carried 5-0. This expense will be turned in to FEMA for reimbursement for costs caused by storm damage. Andreas will call Jasper Construction to begin as there schedule deems possible.
- e. Lambs Grove has also received a quote rom Manatt's for curb repair due to Derecho damage. The quote provided was not broken down by street. Andreas will ask Manatt's to send us new quotes with a break down by street. Council will review new quote at December meeting.
- f. Dumping issue has been addressed, investigated, decided on and reported back to resident. No further action will be made on this matter.

Any funds left after curb repair is completed will be deposited into General Funds account. Exact amounts will be reported as amounts become available.

Old Business: A proposed Ordinance to amend Lambs Grove's Chapter 55 Animal Ordinance to include chickens has been submitted to Council. Bartello made motion to approve Public Hearing for Proposed Ordinance. Wood 2nd motion. Motion carried 5-0. Andreas will publish Notice of Public Hearing to Amend Ordinance in Newton Daily News twice before Public Hearing date of December 5, 2020.

FEMA update: All work and paperwork required for the project with FEMA titled Tree Debris Removal has been completed. Project has been submitted to FEMA Supervisor for approval. Once approved, FEMA will reimburse Lambs Grove for 75% of expenses for tree debris removal from the Derecho. The State of Iowa will reimburse for 10% and then Lambs Grove will be responsible for the remaining 15%.

Humke moved and was seconded by Wood to adjourn the meeting at 8:04 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
