Suzanne M. Kopp-Moskow is the Li'l Herc's Family Fest Organizer and Merchandise Developer for the EQUUS Film Festival, LLC.

Suzanne is the President of Chicago Horse Center of America, a not-for-profit organization formed in 2013 to create and maintain a world-class equestrian center in the city of Chicago that will serve a broad demographic of individuals and communities. Suzanne also is an emeritus trustee of Children's Home & Aid and a former board member of the Brain Research Foundation.

Prior to her decision to dedicate her time and energy to develop the Chicago Horse Center, and other community related projects for children and families, Suzanne was Executive Director of a 'patient facilitation program' program at the University of Chicago Medical Center that she created in 2003. The program focused on helping patients and their families navigate the complexities of a large academic medical center. The program was initiated following the death of her first husband, who died from a debilitating brain disorder in 2002.

Suzanne also practiced law for over 12 years, which included private practice in both New York and Chicago. She served as Regional Corporate Council for T-Mobile, USA. While in law school, Suzanne volunteered time to provide legal assistance to incarcerated individuals to help them prepare for re-entry to society. Suzanne lives in Chicago with her husband Michael and her dog, Frida. She also has a young horse that she fully intends to use for the service of others.
