



Public Education Course: Suddenly in Command

On Saturday, July 14, the Havre de Grace Maritime Museum hosted “Suddenly in Command”, a course designed to help keep your kids and spouse safe by teaching them what to do if you, as the captain of your vessel, suddenly become incapacitated.

Course Overview: The captain becomes incapacitated or falls overboard or you purchase a new boat and step aboard for the first time; *You are Now Suddenly in Command*. What do you do? This 3-hour boating safety class is designed for those NOT usually at the helm, and will help you “be prepared” to perform the basic tasks needed to bring the situation under control.



The cost for the course was \$25

There was no charge for kids under \$15 if accompanied by an adult.

There was no charge for First Responders or Active Duty Military.
