Grant PTA Meeting

June 14, 2016

Meeting called to order at 6:37 by Jessica Lieder

Members Present – Jessica Lieder, Dan Sakai, Steve Gillespie, Alisa Loigman, Juliet Davenport, Laura More, Rachel Kennedy, and Principal Lorden.

Meeting Minutes – motion to approve – Steve Gillespie, seconded Lara Gates. The motion passed.

Administrative Update – Principal Lorden

It's been a great year. Very excited for next year. Thinks are moving in a great direction. The 6th and 7th graders go off campus during the 8th grade promotion. Tomorrow there will be an assembly – Grassology – a Blue Grass band will perform.

Lara Gates inquired as to how the enrollment is looking for next year. Right now without all of our Kindergarteners enrolled we are currently right where the District projects us to be for next year. May have a bump of 15 TK/K compared to the number of 8th graders leaving. Not sure yet if there will be a pure TK class. Looks like will have a 4/5 combo class – seminar students. Looks like there will be a 1st/2nd grade combo – but this can change in the fall based on enrollment numbers. Very few children have indicated that they are leaving. The numbers for 4th and 5th grade will hover around 32 per class. 35 is the maximum that can be in an elementary school classroom. 36 is the maximum for a middle school classroom. The issue of split classes – will this continue every year? Next year Pricipal Lorden will advocate for more choice students in grade where we have a deficit. Won't give more choice students if it means they have to give another teacher. What percentage of the school are choice students? In the range of 20% but would need to verify.

Arduino at Grant - Mr. Snyder

The Foundation purchased a set of Arduino kits for the science classes. It is a microcontroller and is essentially a simple computer. Arduino is easy to program using the free IDE. Combines electrical engineering and programming and is inexpensive and robust. Interesting and engaging for kids. Develops computational thinking skills. Uses inputs and outputs – math that interacts with the outside world (article by Tom Igoe – Stop Teaching Programming, Start Teaching Computational Thinking). Block programming is being used for lower grades. A number of schools in North County compete in competitions – First Robotics, etc. Can be challenging to do competition work with 35 kids in elementary classes but could be done in Middle School.

<u>Fundraising Update and Upcoming Events – Jessica Lieder</u>

Concerts in the park will start soon. 6th Grade Camp will be there fundraising.

August 21st from 1-4. Welcome back picnic at Pioneer Park. Lara Gates is heading it up and would welcome help.

ASB Update - Steve Gillespie

5th Graders were led around the middle school today. Some Seniors from Point Loma will be coming to talk to the 8th graders about high school.

Foundation Update and Imagine Campaign – Jill Baltan

Imagine Campaign – raised \$58,000 for this past year. Allocated \$48,000 to PTA for on-going programs. Allocated \$12,500 for relocation for the Gecko Garden and Outdoor Science Lab. Allocated \$10,000 to the science committee headed by Fiona Case to help with moving towards the new science standards and some hands-on learning elements. Pledged to donate \$50,000 to the PTA next year.

<u>Treasurer Report and Budget – Alisa Loigman</u>

In the last month expenditures have focused on regular operations. Alisa Loigman made a motion to ratify the expenses for May in the amount of \$12,281, seconded by Lara Gates. The motion passed.

2016-2017 Budget overview – reinstated the teacher stipend - \$300 per teacher. It is a supply fund advance, funds will be provided to the teachers in the new fiscal year and teachers will need to provide receipts for items purchased and complete a form. Mr. Snyder thanked the PTA for the stipends. The budget also provides a budget for subscriptions and Principal Lorden with review and coordinate the purchases. Some programs may be purchased over the summer to secure discounts. Have increased ASB funds to \$2000 to help minimize fund raising efforts needed. Steve Gillespie thanked the PTA for this allocation, it makes a big difference. Have included additional funds for assemblies and school trips. Juliet Davenport will be in charge of assemblies for next year. The school trips – will be administered by Principal Lorden and the funds provide travel funds for field trips. Principal Lorden will administer \$5,000 for school trips for the year. The budget has also allocated funds for transportation to 6th Grade Camp. The budget also includes funds for Model United Nations, other Middle School activities and funding of the Science Coordinator positon. Motion to approve the budget was made by Lara Gates and seconded by Jill Baltan. The motion passed.

<u>Fundraising Update</u>

Fundraising Committee is working through the events for next year. The Halloween Carnival, Wine Event, Grant Gala, Jog-a-thon are the big events as well as the Imagine Campaign. Lance Harris will be the Treasurer next year. Jessica Lieder – recognition of outgoing board members – Steve Gillespie, Alisa Loigman, and Meredith Emory and thanked them for their service. Recognition of out-going Foundation President Julie Morgan.

Round Table

Lara has been appointed Chair of the 2017 Mission Hills Garden Walk. Needs to identify gardens in South Mission Hills. There will be trolleys from the Nursery to South Mission Hills. The Mission Hills Garden Club will give Grant \$5,000 and 50% of the proceeds from the event for the Garden relocation. It is a great event held the Saturday before Mother's Day.

Ann Anthony – PTA paid for buses for the Model UN and entry fees- thank you! Took 69 kids to the event and the biggest award you can win is the Best Delegation award – and Grant won it this year!

Science Olympiad – Denice Santorum and her daughter provided some information on the Science Olympiad and thanked PTA for their support.

Alisa Loigman – recognized teachers and parents who have been helping to implement all of the programs that are funded by the PTA.

Jessica Lieder also recognized Toni Rushing's contributions as the Foundation Treasurer.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m. by Jessica Lieder. Have a great summer!
