

Feast of St. Pope John Paul II

This modern Saint and former pope is celebrated on October 22. John Paul II is a familiar name to Catholics today. Many refer to him as "JP2" (Said as 'J P two'), or even St. John Paul the Great. JP2 was born in Poland, and his birth name is Karol Józef Wojtyła. Growing up JP2 was very athletic and enjoyed activities like swimming and skiing. He attended a university in Krakow. JP2 studied in a secret seminary during WWII. After the war he finished his studies and was ordained in 1946

As a pope, JP2 did a lot! He visited 129 countries. He canonized over 400 saints. He was a prolific writer. He started World Youth Day. He also instituted Divine Mercy Sunday.


