ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Energy Assistance - Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP):

Helps individuals and families pay for the cost of heating their homes by providing a one-time benefit payment for each heating season. Household income must be below 150% FPL. Payment covers a portion of heating costs; not intended to cover the entire annual cost of heating a home. Assistance may also be available to help with non-heating electric costs. Other services offered include crisis assistance (available to those who have no heat, have received a disconnection notice, or are nearly out of fuel and do not have any way to pay for heating needs and weatherization services.

- **Section 8 Rental Assistance** - *Qualified Program participants pay a portion of their rent, based on their income, and the Housing Authority pays the rest.*
- **Rental Repair Loans** - *Available to owners of rental properties in Chippewa County.*
- **Home Purchase Programs** - *Helps with down payment and/or closing cost, home repairs that count towards down payment, lease to purchase, as well as self-help.*
- **Housing Rehabilitation Program** - *Assists low and moderate-income households with repairs including plumbing, electrical, heating, insulation, roofing, plus more.*
- **Self-Help Housing** - *Assists first time home buyers. A group of families (4-6) works together to build their own homes under the guidance of contractors.*
- **Lease to Purchase** - *Assists first time homebuyers in purchasing a home after they have rented it for one year.*
- **Emergency Housing Assistance for Home Owners** - *Program helps homeowners pay delinquent property taxes and mortgage payments.*

- **Vision (Volunteer Improvement Service In Our Neighborhoods)** - Assists qualified low-income homeowners with small home repairs. Homeowner pays for materials and vision staff/community volunteers to do the labor.

Lifeline and Link-Up

Lifeline reduces the basic monthly charge for one telephone line for income-eligible households. Link-Up helps households without telephone service, get it and those with service, keep it when they move. Pays for most of the installation charges of one telephone.

Otherwise you must have a household income of 135% FPG (must provide proof) and no one else in the household can have a SafeLink phone.

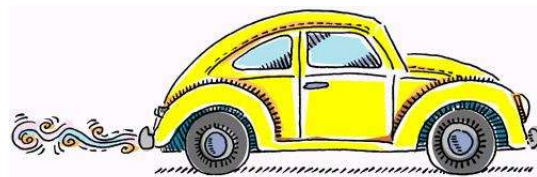
