

Oswego Methodist men serve 75 spaghetti dinners in drive-through giveaway

Oswego, IL--Better late than never.

That described a drive-thru spaghetti dinner giveaway Saturday, July 18, at Church of the Good Shepherd United Methodist in Oswego.
