

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH AN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
INCLUDING THE AREA HEREIN DESCRIBED AND TO BE KNOWN
AS THE SPANISH VALLEY WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT,
WITHIN GRAND COUNTY, STATE OF UTAH

The Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, State of Utah, having met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Board, in the Grand County Court House, Moab, Utah, September 22nd, A.D. 1969, and having determined and declared that the public health, convenience, and necessity requires establishment of an Improvement District within Grand County, State of Utah, notice is hereby given of the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, State of Utah, to establish an Improvement District under the provisions of Chapter 6, Title 17, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, to include the area hereinafter defined and described.

Section 1. The area to be included within the proposed Improvement District is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of Section 16; All of Section 17; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18; NE $\frac{1}{4}$;
NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$; E $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$; N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20; NE $\frac{1}{4}$; N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$;
N $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21; All of Section 22; N $\frac{1}{2}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 27, T 26 S, R 22 E, SLB&M.

Section 2. The proposed name of the Improvement District to be created is the Spanish Valley Water Improvement District, and the District is proposed to be created under Chapter 6, Title 17, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.

Section 3. That all the area to be included within the proposed Improvement District is entirely within Grand County, State of Utah, and no part of such area is included within the boundaries of another Improvement District.

Section 4. That the purposes for which the proposed Improvement District is to be created are to acquire and construct systems for the

collection, treatment, and distribution of water, the operation of all or any part of such systems and to provide services thereof for the inhabitants of such improvement district.


Section 5. That on the 14th day of October, A. D. 1969, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M., the Board of County Commissioners shall meet in their Board Room in the County Court House in Moab, Utah, and will then and there hold a public hearing at which time and place all parties interested may appear before said Board to be heard either in support of or opposition to the creation of the proposed Improvement District and of the area proposed to be included within said Improvement District may on or before said date, protest in writing against creation of the proposed Improvement District and against inclusion of the proposed area or any part thereof within such proposed district, which protest shall be signed by the taxpayer or taxpayers thereof and shall be filed with the County Clerk of Grand County in Moab, Utah.

Section 6. Notice of intention to create the proposed Improvement District shall be given by publication in accordance with this Resolution, once a week for three (3) successive weeks in the Times Independent, a weekly newspaper published in Grand County, Utah, and having general circulation within said County, under the caption, "Notice of Intention to Create the Spanish Valley Water Improvement District within Grand County, Utah," and the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to publish such notice.

Section 7. This Notice is given in accordance with Section 17-6-3, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended.

After the meeting had been duly called to order, the roll called with the above result, and the minutes of the last meeting had been read and approved, the following ordinance was introduced in writing by Commissioners A. Daniel Holyoak and D. L. Taylor and seconded by

The Resolution and Ordinance is as follows:

Resolution determining and declaring that the public health convenience and necessity requires the creation of Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District of the area in the ordinance described all within Grand County, State of Utah, and notice to create such improvement district.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners on the 4th day of March 1974 approved a Resolution declaring that the public health convenience and necessity required the establishment of an improvement district within Grand County, Utah and

WHEREAS the County Commissioners of Grand County published notice of intention to establish an improvement district including the area described in said notice and to be known as the Spanish Valley Water and

Sewer Improvement District, and

WHEREAS said notice provided that a public hearing be held on the 8th day of April 1974 at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. in the Board room in the Court House in Moab, Utah at which time all interested parties may appear before the board to be heard either in support of or in opposition to the proposed improvement district, and

WHEREAS said notice was published in the Times Independent, a weekly newspaper of general circulation for four successive weeks beginning on the 14th day of March 1974 and ending on the 4th day of April 1974, and

WHEREAS on the 8th day of April 1974, said public hearing was held, and after investigation and consideration of all the circumstances Board of County Commissioners has determined that the public health, convenience and necessity require the creation of the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District in order to provide for water and sewer and preserve the health, promote the prosperity, improve the morals, peace and order, comfort and convenience of Grand County, State of Utah, and the inhabitants thereof and in order to carry into effect the provisions of chapter 6, title 17, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and good cause appearing the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, adopt an Ordinance as follows:

1. There is hereby established and created under Chapter 6, Title 17, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District, which district shall include all the property and lands described in the notice of intention to establish the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District within Grand County, published in the Times Independent on March 14th, March 21st, March 28th and April 1974.

2. All the functions, activities, and responsibilities of the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District shall be performed and carried out in accordance with and subject to Chapter 6, Title 17, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and other applicable law.

3. The County Commissioners have determined that the interest in the district would be best served by the appointment of a Board of _____ Five trustees to serve for the same term as is provided for elected trustees. The following persons are appointed to serve as trustees of the Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District:


