*Open to all. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.*

*Fence height 2'6".*

100. Marshall & Sterling Bit of Straw Hunter Classic- Two round class(\$50)

*Open to junior or amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into the M&S Children's or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider into any rated hunter division.*

200. Marshall & Sterling Children's/ Adults 2'6 Medal

*Open to Junior/ Amateur Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show.*

*Open to riders who are still limit riders as of Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>. Fences not to exceed 2'0" for ponies and 2'6" for the horses.*

## **PRE ENTRIES ARE GREATLY APPRECIATED**

### **Rules and Regulations**

1. All riders must wear protective headgear at all times, including schooling areas.
2. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss, or damage occurring at the show.
3. All entry blanks to be completely filled out, signed, and given to the secretary, with fees paid.
4. Schooling will be permitted only in the areas provided by the committee, and scheduled as time permits.
5. Hunter courses may include gates, bush, walls, oxers, in-and-outs, coops, rolltops, post and rails.
6. Jumper courses may include post and rails, gates, oxers, walls, panels, coops or any combination of the above.
7. All pets must be leashed while on show grounds.
8. Hunters will be judged on performance, manners and soundness.
9. Post entries accepted at no additional charge.
10. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged therewith.
11. Ties other than first place remain tied.
12. Every animal in the show is under the control of the owner. Red Oak Farm will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold Red Oak Farm blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
13. Management reserves the rights to shift divisions to alternate ring to facilitate time schedule.
14. \$50 Fee non-negotiable checks.
15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Take Exit 30 B / North Maple Ave

Take North Maple Ave approx 1.8 miles, it then becomes South Maple Ave.

Follow South Maple Ave approx 2.7 Miles to the blinking light.

Stay straight onto Long Hill Rd

Go approx 1 mile to stop sign & make a left on to Pleasant Plains Rd

Immediately make the 1st right to stay on Pleasant Plains Rd

Farm will be approx 1 mile on right

Use the 1st driveway entrance by the house.

**From 78 East**

Take Exit 36

Make left off exit onto King George Rd.

Go approx 1.2 miles to end & make right onto Valley Rd

Take Valley Rd approx 2.1 miles to traffic light.

Make a left onto Main Ave.

Approx ½ mile cross railroad tracks & the road becomes Central Ave

Go another 1/2 mile up hill & stay straight onto Pleasant Plains Rd.

Immediately make the 1st right to stay on Pleasant Plains Rd

Farm will be approx 1 mile on right

Use the 1st driveway entrance by the house.
