We have five or six companies running trash trucks through Bay Hills every week spread over SIX days! Extra wear & tear on roads

and nerves, & extra pollution in the air. PLEASE consider switching to TOTE (727-422-0736) to get once weekly trash with or without recycling. Prices are reasonable and NO CHARGE for 96 gallon trash can. You can put out up to 3 of your own cans if you have more trash. An extra 96 gallon can is \$7/month. If you choose recycling, there's NO CHARGE for the 65 gallon recycle can. You pay \$27/month for trash only. \$34/month covers trash AND recycling.

NO company offers HOA discounts anymore unless all bills are paid by ONE account.

(examples: condominiums, apartment complexes, neighborhoods with mandatory HOA's that can dictate what trash company to use)
