IV-D Magistrate position now available in Nineteenth Judicial District Applications due August 14, 2017

As a result of the retirement of Magistrate Randall Davis to the district court bench effective September 30, 2017, the IV-D (.30 FTE) magistrate position will become vacant in the Nineteenth Judicial District.

We currently are accepting applications for a .30 IV-D child support magistrate. The successful candidate's schedule will be every Monday plus the first and third Tuesday of each month. Funding is derived from a two-thirds IV-D federal grant and one-third district matching funds. Every application for consideration must be filed electronically in accordance with all instructions including those contained in this comment. No exceptions. Failure to complete the electronic application in its entirety will disqualify the applicant from participation in further stages of the hiring process. You may attach a resume; however, this does substitute for the requirement to fully complete the electronic application per instructions. Incomplete electronic applications and those reflecting "see resume" will not be considered. The salary of \$3,772 per month is set by the State Judicial Department and is not negotiable.
