No.5 Georgia upset No. 1 Texas 30-15 last Saturday night. The Bulldogs were 4-point underdogs and led 23-0 at halftime. It was the largest deficit for any No. 1 team at halftime since the 2013 BCS National Championship game between No. 1 Notre Dame and No. 2 Alabama. The Bulldogs got 7 sacks in the game.

Misleading Finals

Duke (-2.5) beat Florida State 23-16. However, FSU had a 291-180 yard edge but were -4 in TO's which included a "Pick 6". At one point, the Noles turned it over on 3 straight plays. Duke was 0-22 all-time vs FSU prior to the win.

Navy (-16.5) crushed Charlotte 51-17. However, Charlotte had a 363-288 yard edge but were -5 in TO's. Navy got a 61-yard "Pick 6" and an 84-yard "Pick 6". Navy is 6-0 for the first time since 1979.

Central Michigan (+3) led Eastern Michigan 34-16. However, they allowed the game's final 22 points and didn't cover.

Utah State (+1) led New Mexico 17-0 and still led 38-23 in the second half but lost 50-45.

Memphis (-11) beat North Texas 52-44. However, North Texas had a 653-526 yard edge.

Toledo (+3) upset Northern Illinois 13-6. However, NIU had a 391-285 yard edge. The Huskies were stopped on downs at the Toledo 47, 39, 26 and 41-yard lines while also missing a 47-yard FG.

South Florida (-14) beat UAB 35-25. However, UAB had a 485-355 yard edge and led 19-7 in the third quarter.

NC State (+9.5) upset California 24-23. However, California had a 23-10 lead entering the fourth quarter.

South Carolina (-1) crushed Oklahoma 35-9. However, Oklahoma had a 291-254 yard edge but were -4 in TO's. SC incredibly had 9 sacks by 9 different players.

Tulane (-22.5) beat Rice 24-10. However, Rice had a 344-306 yard edge but the Owls were -5 in TO's.

Mississippi State had a 367-353 yard edge vs Texas A&M in a 34-24 loss.

Illinois (+5.5) beat Michigan 21-7. However, Michigan had a 322-267 yard edge but the Wolverines were -3 in TO's.

Bad Beats

The total in the Fresno State/Nevada game was 50. It was 24-21 with 4:13 left in the 3Q but neither team scored from that point forward. Fresno had a 1st and Goal at the 5-yard line late but didn't score.

Marshall got a 88-yard TD run with 1:39 left to cover the 9.5-point spread and put the game OVER the 51.5 total in their 35-20 win.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Wednesday, October 23rd

Liberty 35 KENNESAW STATE 13. We're not buying this unbeaten Liberty team. The Flames have played the weakest schedule in the country and have not beat any team by more than 18. Kennesaw is bad (especially on offense), but have only lost once by more than this huge spread and have played teams like UTSA, ULL and San Jose.

JACKSONVILLE STATE 40 Middle Tennessee 20. After an 0-3 start, Jacksonville has 3 straight wins all by 37 or more points. That doesn't bode well for a MTSU team that already has 4 losses by 27 or more points. Our power ratings can't get to the number.

Thursday, October 24th

PITTSBURGH 33 Syracuse 28. Both teams have exceeded expectations so far this season. Unbeaten Pitt has been much more dominant with a +2.4 ypp margin (No. 9 in country) vs Syracuse who is -0.1 in ypp margin (No. 87). Early week market is all over this as Pitt has gone from as low as -3.5 to the current -6.

OLD DOMINION 27 Georgia Southern 26. Both teams pulled outright upsets as double-digit underdogs last week. ODU beat Texas State as a 10.5-point underdog and GS beat James Madison as a 10-point dog. ODU has been the better team in the stats (-0.4 ypp margin vs -1.2). We're not surprised they have went from dog to favorite here.

Friday, October 25th

Louisville 30 BOSTON COLLEGE 24. Both teams need a win. Louisville has lost 3 of their last 4 (albeit all to ranked teams) while BC has lost back-to-back. Louisville is still +1.5 in ypp margin (No. 25) but we can't lay more than a TD with them on the road on a short week while BC played last Thursday.

USC 34 Rutgers 21. Big Ten play has not been kind to USC as the Trojans are 1-4 and were actually favored in 4 of their 5 games. They suffered another inexcusable loss last week at Maryland after leading by 2 TD's in the second half. Meanwhile, Rutgers has lost 3 straight and their defense gave up 35 to a poor UCLA offense last week.

Boise State 35 UNLV 31. This could be the best "Group of 5" game of the entire season and the first of two meetings. Both rank in the top 40 of our power ratings and the winner becomes the favorite to make the playoffs. Boise RB Jeanty is on pace for an all-time season but the Broncos also lead the nation in sacks (29) on defense and rank No. 2 in offensive ypp. We can't get last year's Mountain West championship game (Boise 44-20 win at UNLV) out of our minds.

Saturday, October 26th

TOLEDO 26 Bowling Green 21. Both teams have been banged up recently and keep an eye on Toledo QB Tucker Gleason's status. He missed last week's game but Toledo still pulled the road upset at NIU. BG has beat the 3 worst teams on their schedule and lost to the 4 best (twice as a favorite). We trust UT more even if they're playing with the backup and don't understand the OVER money.

MIAMI 38 Florida State 17. Miami has never been this big of a favorite in this series (previous high was -14 in 2018). It is deserved. The Canes have the massive statistical edge as they are +3.0 in ypp margin while FSU is -1.0. The Canes have the No. 1 offense in the country averaging 577 ypp while FSU's offense ranks No. 132 (276 ypp). However, we do expect a solid FSU effort here.

UCF 28 BYU 27. A very dangerous game for unbeaten BYU here. The Cougars have been outgained in wins over Kansas State and Baylor, were +3 in TO's vs Arizona and last week scored in the final seconds vs Oklahoma State after converting a 4th&7. UCF nearly pulled the stunner at Iowa State last week. They do here even though they flipped to favorite yesterday.

VIRGINIA 31 North Carolina 27. Did the bye help or hurt NC? The Tar Heels had lost 4 straight prior including in agonizing fashion to GT and you have to feel this is the final stretch for HC Mack Brown. UVA is off back-to-back losses but the Cavs covered in both games. Our ratings like UVA but we haven't gotten to the window yet.

Eastern Michigan 27 AKRON 26. This could be a sneaky game in the MAC. Akron has played the much more difficult schedule (No. 68 vs No. 147 in Sagarin) and have similar stats (-1.4 in ypp margin vs EMU's -1.3). EMU is off a thrilling come-from-behind win over rival CMU last week (trailed 34-16, won 38-34). Our ratings like EMU but the situation favors Akron off a bye.

JAMES MADISON 38 Southern Miss 15. Both teams are facing some adversity here. JMU has now lost twice as a big favorite including last week at Georgia Southern (-10). Meanwhile Southern Miss just fired their coach Will Hall. Reed Stringer will serve as the interim. We haven't bet side or total.

Northern Illinois 32 BALL STATE 20. Keep an eye on the status of NIU QB Ethan Hampton who missed last week's upset loss to Toledo. NIU still ranks No. 13 in the country with a +142 ypp margin and have outgained Buffalo by 175 yards, NC State by 108 yards and Toledo by 106 yards but have lost all 3. They're facing a Ball State defense that ranks dead last in ypp margin (-2.8).

VIRGINIA TECH 31 Georgia Tech 21. Will he GT QB Haynes King play or won't he? It was reported that he would be out here but HC Brent Key said that wasn't the case. We think King is doubtful. They missed him last week in a 31-13 loss to ND as the offense managed only 64 rushing yards. VT looks to be hitting their stride after back-to-back comfortable wins. We're not involved yet.

OHIO 27 Buffalo 21. Both teams come in off losses last week and can ill-afford another in conference play. Ohio is the better team in the stats (+0.4 ypp margin vs -0.3) and Buffalo has been outgained by 80 ypp (No. 120). We lean OVER at current.

APPALACHIAN STATE 34 Georgia State 27. This is Appalachian State's first home game since Hurricane Helene flooded the region. It should be an emotional atmosphere. App State hung tough in road losses to Marshall and ULL but are coming off a bye. Georgia St is better in the stats (-0.7 ypp margin vs -1.1) and played a similar schedule (No. 71 vs No. 72). Lean UNDER.

WESTERN MICHIGAN 40 Kent State 23. We like the OVER here as both team's defenses are horrific. Kent Stat ranks dead last allowing 538 ypp while WMU ranks No. 127 allowing 456 ypp. Both teams offenses have fared better in MAC play as WMU is averaging 42 ppg while Kent St is averaging 25 ppg (just 10 ppg in non-conference).

Smu 31 DUKE 20. A pair of 6-1 teams but SMU has been far more impressive vs a tougher schedule (No. 55 vs No. 92). The Mustangs are +1.6 in ypp margin while Duke is +0.7. The Blue Devils had a misleading 23-16 win over FSU last week as they only gained 180 yards on offense but were +4 in TO's. We don't like the travel spot though for SMU who flew to the West coast last week and now fly to the East.

MIAMI, OH 29 Central Michigan 19. We've been saying this for weeks but CMU games have been a little fishy this season with most games falling near the number in peculiar ways. CMU led EMU 34-16 last week but didn't cover in a 38-34 loss as 3-point underdogs. After a tough early schedule, the Red Hawks seem to be finding their stride. Still tough trusting them to cover this number.

EAST CAROLINA 28 Temple 22. ECU fired head coach Mike Houston last week. It was a little surprising if you look at ECU's schedule down the stretch, they could make a bowl. Temple is off back-to-back covers and got the win last week vs Tulsa as QB Evan Simon returned from injury. Our ratings lean ECU but we like Temple's current form.

KENTUCKY 23 Auburn 20. Two teams that have underachieved greatly this season and neither one looks to be heading to a bowl game. Auburn is the much better team in the stats (+2.0 ypp margin vs -0.6). However, how can you trust them off 4 straight losses including blowing a 17-3 lead last week at Missouri. UK has already lost 3 times outright as a favorite this year. Pass.

CONNECTICUT 27 Rice 23. Both teams are +0.9 in ypp margin and Rice has played the tougher schedule (No. 99 vs No. 127). The Owls had a misleading loss at Tulane last week where they had a -5 TO margin. UConn is in the midst of a 6-game home-stand. They did lose to Wake last week (first home loss of season). We bet Rice and OVER.

† **Notre Dame 34 Navy 20.** @MetLife Stadium in East Rutherford, N.J. Navy's offense has been dynamite under new OC Drew Cronin as they rank No. 4 in scoring at 44.8 ppg. Navy QB Blake Horvath has a 10-1 TD-to-INT ratio while also running for 10 TD's. Meanwhile, ND boasts the No. 5 scoring defense allowing just 11.9 ppg. The difference is the massive strength of schedule as ND has played the No. 51 schedule while Navy has played the No. 144 schedule and the Mids have not played a defense in the Top 75 of our rankings.

ARKANSAS STATE 28 Troy 21. Despite a 4-3 record, Arkansas St is -1.6 in ypp margin which ranks No. 127. Meanwhile, Troy at 1-6 on the season is -0.8 in ypp margin. However, they are banged up at QB. We don't have a great feel for this one. Pass.

MICHIGAN 22 Michigan State 18. The dynamics of this game changed dramatically in just one week. Michigan lost outright 21-7 as a favorite at Illinois and Michigan State, off a bye, upset Iowa 32-20 as 6.5-point underdogs. MSU is the better team in the stats as they are +0.7 in ypp margin while the Wolverines are 0.0. The Michigan offense is the worst unit on the field ranking No. 119 in total offense. Our power ratings like Michigan here but the eye test says Sparty. We're passing for now.

MINNESOTA 25 Maryland 21. We don't mind the spot here for Minnesota coming off the bye while they catch Maryland off the dramatic come-from-behind upset win over USC last week. The Gophers also have the better ypp margin (+0.8 vs +0.2) despite playing a similar schedule. However, we don't think there's great value at current.

INDIANA 30 Washington 24. No Power 4 conference team has exceeded expectation more than Indiana so far this season. The Hoosiers rank No. 1 in scoring offense at 48.7 ppg and are No. 1 in scoring margin at 35.0 ppg. Last week was supposed to be their toughest test and they crushed Nebraska 56-7. This week will be even tougher especially without QB Kurtis Rourke. They're playing a Washington team off a bye and the Huskies rank No. 10 in ypp margin and No. 8 in ypg margin this season. We lean UW.

TCU 36 Texas Tech 30. TCU is much better in the stats as the Horned Frogs are +1.1 in ypp margin while Texas Tech is -0.3. The two teams are off disparate results as Tech lost 59-35 as 4.5-point home favorites to Baylor. Meanwhile, TCU pulled the road upset of Utah 13-7 as 3-point underdogs. There's been a battle in the market here (early money on TCU, buy back on Texas Tech yesterday). Pass at current.

SOUTH ALABAMA 27 UL-Monroe 20. It's tough to get margin on this ULM team who is running the 2nd slowest tempo in the country. Their offense ranks just No. 130 averaging 280 ypg but their defense is allowing just 20 ppg. South Alabama is the better team but the Jags also run a slow tempo (No. 113).

TEXAS A&M 27 Lsu 25. The game of the week as neither team has lost an SEC game yet (both have big hurdles left). LSU is off arguably their best defensive performance in the last two years as they held Arkansas to 10 points. The Tigers have 24 sacks in their last 5 games and have only allowed 2 sacks all season. A&M is better in ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.8) and Kyle Field at night is difficult. We agree with the early week money on LSU.

Utah 21 HOUSTON 17. It's tough backing either team at this point. Utah has lost 3 straight games outright as a favorite and fired their long-time OC Andy Ludwig. Interim OC Mike Bajakian was one of the worst in the country in his Northwestern days. We thought Houston was about to turn the corner after upsetting TCU but the Cougars were blown out by Kansas last week. We haven't bet side or total.

OLE MISS 33 Oklahoma 14. This is the largest underdog role for Oklahoma in any game since 1997. The Sooners offense ranks No. 132 in ypp and just fired co-OC Seth Littrell. Kevin Johns is expected to have an increased role. The Sooners are taking on an Ole Miss team that is better than their record as the Rebels are No. 1 in ypp margin and No. 1 in ypg margin despite two losses. With that said, we didn't bet side or total yet in this game.

BAYLOR 33 Oklahoma State 28. Early week money has been on Baylor here. The Bears are off a blowout upset win over Texas Tech last week. They are the better team in the stats at +0.8 ypp margin (OSU -0.8). Oklahoma State's defense ranks No. 130 in the country allowing 491 ypg. However, we lean UNDER here.

Tulane 37 NORTH TEXAS 30. An "inside-out" handicap here. Tulane is off a misleading win over Rice where they were out-gained by benefited from a +5 TO margin. Meanwhile, North Texas had a 653-526 yard edge in a loss at Memphis. Early week money has been on the home dog and the OVER and we agree.

ALABAMA 33 Missouri 20. After Alabama led Georgia 28-0, we've seen the worst stretch of Alabama football since 2007. Yet we still have the Tide No. 6 in our power ratings. They are No. 12 in ypp margin despite playing the No. 3 schedule. Speaking of schedule, Missouri has played the No. 102 schedule. We think the Tigers are fraudulent. We lean UNDER.

MEMPHIS 39 Charlotte 19. The Memphis defense that we thought was much improved this season got exposed last week allowing 653 yards to North Texas. Meanwhile, Charlotte was -5 in TO's in a 51-17 loss to Navy where they actually out-gained the Mids. Our ratings like Memphis, the "inside-out" handicap says Charlotte. Pass.

Texas 37 VANDERBILT 17. Vanderbilt has covered all 4 games as a dog this year and won 3 of them outright. Vandy QB Pavia has a 11-1 TD-to-INT ratio and leads the team in rushing. However, the Texas defense ranks No. 1 in ypp, ypg and ppg and weren't the problem last week in their loss to Georgia. Our ratings say Texas, but don't want to fade Vandy as a dog.

KANSAS STATE 31 Kansas 22. The Sunflower Showdown has seen Kansas State win 15 straight but the two are 4-4 ATS in their last 8. We really like what we saw from Kansas off the bye. Despite a 2-5 record, they are +0.9 in ypp, +50.0 ypg and +6.4 ppg. We like them at +10 or more.

Arkansas 33 MISSISSIPPI STATE 24. Mississippi State has covered their last 3 games against some SEC powers in Texas, Georgia and Texas A&M all as a 3-TD underdog or more. Now they're catching a TD here against an Arkansas team off a disappointing loss to LSU. Our numbers say Arkansas here who is No. 18 in ypp margin +123.4.

Utah 32 TULSA 23. Tulsa found themselves underdog to lowly Temple last week and were controlled 20-10. Now they face a UTSA team that probably should have a better record if not for a last-second loss to Rice a few weeks ago. We lean UTSA.

COLORADO 29 Cincinnati 24. Colorado is coming off another impressive performance last week in their blowout win over Arizona. That's now 5 straight covers for the Buffs by 17.1 points per game. Last year they got a lot of media love but didn't deserve it. Now they deserve it, and it is quiet on the media front. Cincinnati is a much improved team this season as well. We lean UNDER.

COLORADO STATE 35 New Mexico 31. New Mexico games are incredibly 6-1 to the OVER by an average of 20.1 points per game. Last week was no different in their 50-45 come-from-behind win over Utah State. Their games are now averaging 80.4 total ppg. Colorado State is a little more balanced from offense to defense but we think NM's offense is the best unit in this matchup.

Utah State 29 WYOMING 28. A lot of money came in on Utah State on Wednesday morning as they flipped from underdog to favorite here. We agree with the move as the Aggies are -0.4 in ypp margin while Wyoming is -2.0. Utah State also played the more difficult schedule than Wyoming (No. 62 vs No. 85).

ARIZONA 27 West Virginia 26. Keep an eye on the status of WVU QB Greene. We think he is likely not going to play in this game but we do lean with WVU. The backup Marchiol is not that big of a downgrade and Arizona is also dealing with some injuries as their top defender (LB Manu) and LT are out for the season.

CALIFORNIA 31 Oregon State 18. Cal is 3-4 on the season but easily could be 7-0 if not for the worst FG kicking situation in the country. The Bears are still +0.4 in ypp margin despite playing a much tougher schedule (No. 35 vs No. 88) than the Beavers who are -0.7 in ypp margin. Oregon State has struggled against Mountain West teams in recent weeks (1-2 SU/0-3 ATS) and now are taking a step up in class.

Washington State 35 SAN DIEGO STATE 21. Keep an eye at the line of scrimmage here. San Diego State is +12 in sack differential (sacks minus sacks allowed) while Washington State is -10. The Cougars have only lost to Boise State this season and will be favored in their remaining games. San Diego State is off a bye after back-to-back wins. We like their true freshman QB Danny O'Neil but need more than 14 to get involved here.

FRESNO STATE 30 San Jose State 25. San Jose State is the better team in the stats at +1.4 in ypp margin while Fresno State is +0.5. However, Fresno has played the more difficult schedule (No. 79 vs No. 131). We don't see any value here at current.

Wake Forest 28 STANFORD 26. Stanford is out of gas and banged up after a very tough stretch. They made three long road trips and have played 4 straight Top 30 opponents getting blown out in each. They're taking a step down in class here and Wake is on back-to-back travel after playing at UConn last week. Pass.

Penn State 28 WISCONSIN 21. This game has gotten a lot more interesting in recent weeks. Wisconsin has won and covered 3 straight games as they have outscored their opponents by a combined 117-16. Penn State is off a bye after the USC thriller and have Ohio State on deck. Wisconsin is the sharp side but don't see much value at current.

IOWA 27 Northwestern 14. Iowa is off an upset loss to Michigan State. They're playing a bad Northwestern offense that ranks No. 129 averaging just 286.6 ypg. The problem is can you trust Iowa enough to get margin. Both teams run slow tempos (No. 116 and No. 108).

OHIO STATE 37 Nebraska 12. The Buckeyes come in off a bye after their defense was embarrassed vs Oregon. Nebraska is definitely not the team to further expose them as the Huskers were destroyed by Indiana last week. We see another blowout loss but don't see value.

OREGON 37 Illinois 16. What Illinois OL will show up? The one that allowed 12 sacks to Penn State and Purdue or the one that neutralized Michigan's front last week? On the other side, Illinois' defense is facing the best offense they've seen all year. Does No. 1 Oregon have motivation for margin in the playoff era?

Nevada 24 HAWAII 23. Will Nevada QB Lewis play in this game? As of press-time he is questionable. Nevada has been pretty consistent this year at 5-2-1 ATS. They're slight better in the stats and have played the tougher schedule. Hawaii is 0-5 vs FBS teams this year. It all comes down to Lewis' status.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Minnesota 24 L.A. RAMS 22. The Vikings suffered their first loss and non-cover of the season last week vs Detroit. They are still No. 5 in ypp margin vs a tough schedule while the Rams are No. 27 in ypp margin. This is a tough spot for them traveling on a short week and several sharp groups took the Rams earlier this week. Lean Rams at +3.

Sunday, October 27th

DETROIT 27 Tennessee 17. Two QB situations, teams and franchises heading in opposite directions here. The Lions are No. 2 in DVOA (advanced metric), the Titans are No. 27. Detroit is +6 in TO's, Tennessee is -9. Detroit covers point spreads (5-1), Tennessee does not (1-5). With that said, after road trips to Dallas and Minnesota and with road trips to Houston and Green Bay on deck, this is not a good spot for the Lions to be laying doubles. Lean Tennessee at +11.

Baltimore 25 CLEVELAND 17. Cleveland will start Jameis Winston at QB after Deshaun Watson's injury. We think it could be an upgrade and maybe even a significant one considering Watson was by far the worst QB in the NFL this season. It could also be an upgrade in the locker-room. Ken Dorsey is going to call plays too. Baltimore is No. 1 in DVOA while Cleveland is No. 31. However, this is a lot of points to lay in a division game on a short week and traveling again.

Green Bay 25 JACKSONVILLE 21. Obviously, Green Bay is better in the stats at No. 3 in ypp margin while Jacksonville is No. 23. The Packers are +6 in TO's while Jacksonville is -4. Also Jacksonville returns home from a 2-week stay in London. Is that a positive or a negative? Last year, they won off their 2-game road trip. We're staying away for now.

HOUSTON 24 Indianapolis 20. Indianapolis has been underrated in the markets all season as the Colts are 6-1 ATS. They're not dominant statistically but are 0.0 in ypp margin vs an average schedule. The Texans offense was really bad last week. They managed only 197 yards in a deceiving 24-22 loss. These division games between these two are usually close including a 2-point Houston win in the opener.

MIAMI 24 Arizona 21. How much rust will Tua Tagovailoa have in his return? The Cardinals are the better team in the stats and have played one of the toughest schedules in the NFL so far this season. However, they are traveling on a short week after a nice win. We'll call Miami by 3 and see where the market is later in the week.

Atlanta 24 TAMPA BAY 23. Tampa's loss to Baltimore on MNF was worse than the scoreboard and they lost their top WR Godwin for the season. A lot of money has come in on Atlanta here even after the Falcons lost to the Seahawks by 20 at home on Sunday. It was misleading as they were -3 in TO's. The Falcons are better in the stats but the Bucs have played the tougher schedule. We can't get to this number in our ratings and think TB is a good teaser option.

Chicago 22 WASHINGTON 21. The Bears come in off a bye. They've exceeded expectation so far this season at 5-1 ATS but the stats have not backed it up at -0.3 in ypp margin. The Commanders are 5-1-1 ATS but are +0.4 in ypp margin. Will Jayden Daniels play here and if he does, will he be very limited in the run game? As of now, we prefer to tease Washington here up to +8.5.

N.Y. Jets 24 NEW ENGLAND 16. Two of the most disappointing teams in the NFL so far this season. The two teams are a combined 3-11 SU and 3-10-1 ATS. The Jets are obviously still the better team as they are +0.2 in ypp margin while the Pats rank No. 31 at -1.2. The Jets have also played the tougher schedule and NE is off a London trip.

Buffalo 24 SEATTLE 23. Buffalo is the better team at +0.4 in ypp margin while Seattle is +0.2 in ypp margin on the season. Both teams have played similar strength of schedules and both are off blowout wins. With that being said, we can't get this one to Buffalo -3 in our ratings. We definitely lean with the Seahawks here.

L.A. CHARGERS 24 New Orleans 16. The New Orleans Saints in current form, with a backup QB and several other starters banged up could be the worst team in the NFL. That's saying something considering how bad some of these teams are this season. The Chargers are off the close loss on MNF. We don't like laying more than a TD with their slow style (5-1 to the UNDER) but they are definitely a good teaser option this week down to -1 or -1.5.

CINCINNATI 25 Philadelphia 22. The Bengals are the better team in the stats (+0.6 ypp margin vs +0.3). They are just 1-4 in one possession games and could easily have a better record. Meanwhile, the Eagles are 3-1 in close games and could easily be worse. Both teams got relatively easy wins on the road in division play and both need wins here to stay in contention with other teams ahead of them. We think the Bengals could be a "play-on" team for a few weeks.

Kansas City 25 LAS VEGAS 17. Sure, the Chiefs are the last unbeaten team in the NFL. They have played a tough schedule but are only +0.2 in ypp margin. QB Mahomes only has a 6-to-8 TD-to-INT ratio on the season. They're playing a Las Vegas team that is one of the worst-coached teams in football. However, the Raiders tend to play above their weight class in these types of games and we actually like them catching the doubles here. Only one of their six wins this season have come by more than 10 points and they're off a big win at San Francisco. The Raiders are -13 in TO's but their defense has held three straight opponents under 300 yards. We like the Raiders.

DENVER 25 Carolina 15. Breaking news right before we went to press is that the Carolina Panthers plan on starting Bryce Young for this game. Safe to say he is a downgrade for a 1-6 Carolina team that is also 1-6 ATS. They were destroyed by Washington last week and just might have the worst culture in the NFL due to an extremely bad owner. It's tough laying points with a Denver team that is also limited with a rookie QB but the Broncos are +0.5 in ypp margin (No. 9) and are 5-2 ATS with three wins by 16 points or more. They have extra rest off a TNF blowout of New Orleans.

SAN FRANCISCO 24 Dallas 21. Obviously, the 49ers have gotten the best of the Cowboys the last 3 years winning and covering all 3 match-ups with two of them coming in the playoffs. Both teams desperately need a win here. The Cowboys are off a bye and a blowout loss at home to the Lions. They are 0-3 at home and 3-0 on the road. Somehow the 49ers are 3-4 on the season despite being favored in every one of those games. Can you say underachieving? They still have the big coaching edge here but we like the spot for Dallas. The market does to as this line was as high as 6.5.

Monday, October 28th

PITTSBURGH 21 N.Y. Giants 15. The Steelers are 5-2 SU and 5-2 ATS but still find themselves -0.2 in ypp margin. They are +9 in TO's and the move back to QB Wilson was successful in their blowout win over the Jets on SNF. They're taking on a woeful Giants team that has scored a combined 10 points in their last two games (both at home). The Giants are No. 28 in ypp margin. Easy Pittsburgh win and cover right? We're not so sure as these are typically the spots where Tomlin and Co. are totally buttoned up.
