



Shore Acres Yacht Club offers full day and half day programs. Full day programs run from 9:00-4:00. Half day programs run from 9:00-12:00 or 1:00-4:00. All students may stay for lunch hour from 12:00-12:45 daily. Classes are Monday-Friday from June 27-August 19. There will be no classes on July 4 or July 12 (our Ironman regatta).

We typically recommend that beginners join our morning class. More advanced and older students should participate in our afternoon class. We provide club boats for first and second year students. These boats will be an Optimist for younger and smaller students. Older and taller students will use either a Sunfish, Laser, or a 420.

Our instructors are all US Sailing certified and First Aid and CPR certified. They are all experienced sailors and racers.

We ask our parents, or a qualified adult on their part, to participate in our program through our Parent of the Day. Normally this involves 1/2 day four times during the season. You will stay at the club and be available if any situation should arise, such as a sick or injured student. You are free to relax, read, and enjoy watching your child sail.

There are two classifications of fees. If the sailor's parents or grandparents belong to SAYC they pay the member rates. If the parents are not members, the junior sailor is required to join the club as a junior member. Fees are listed :
