Chalone Vineyard Winemaker Greg Freeman's expansive background combines 20 years of Monterey County winemaking with long-standing interests in art, science, and music. Greg's official wine career began in a lab in 2003 at Hahn Winery. Greg quickly progressed to winemaker and was involved with multiple brands, working closely with Nicholas Hahn and Paul Clifton, Director of Winemaking at Hahn. Since 2017, Greg has held positions as winemaker for Georis/Cowgirl Winery in Carmel Valley, California, and Messina Hof Winery in Bryan, Texas. He joined Chalone Vineyard in 2021, bringing two decades of Monterey winemaking to bear as he writes the latest chapter in Chalone's storied history. When Greg isn't making wine, you might find him on Fridays playing bagpipes at sunset in Carmel by the beach.

About Chalone Vineyard: Perched in California's remote Gavilan Mountain range at 1,800 foot elevation, Chalone's rugged vineyards border the Pinnacles National Park and is Monterey County's oldest producing vineyard since 1919. The Chalone AVA where Chalone's vineyards are located is known for its Burgundian-like limestone-based soils, well-drained ground, and limited rainfall that are ideal for growing the winery's limited production Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Blanc, Chenin Blanc, and Syrah. **Fun fact: Chalone's 1974 Chardonnay placed 3rd in the legendary 1976 Judgement of Paris, among some of the best California and French white wines.**
