This issue marks a year since the debut of the **VCMEC Model** Horse Re-View. After the establishment of our website www. vcmec.org in December 2014, the purchase of our home-tobe in April 2015, and the first VCMECongress live show in May 2016, a newsletter seemed like a natural next step.

In introducing it, I wrote, "It's a steamy August evening. Just the latest night of imagining the opening of the Vintage Custom Model Equine Center Hobby House & Museum, and looking forward to looking back on how it happened. Tonight is a little different, though. This night marks the start of the **VCMEC** [Model] Horse Re-View, a quarterly online publication to help chart our way through the flow of time."

We're a year further along that flow now--and almost as if to mark the anniversary, your editor had a strikingly vivid dream the other night. It's still resonating.

In it, I'd won a preliminary leg of a singing contest (in real life I'm just an amateur) and been awarded a trip to go compete in the final. Getting a chance to try was a dream come true! A friend who I've long looked up to was helping me pack. I told her how stunned I was to have won the chance, because I'd sung the theme song of an anime series from the '70s and been worried it might be too old and obscure a choice.

She pointed out something I had somehow not been aware of: that the old anime series was riding a new wave of popularity, thanks to a modern-day reboot.

"Your dream came true because now the time is best for it," she said. "Don't ever forget: Time your dream!"

I woke up with "time your dream" etched in mind. Yeah, it sounds like a slogan you might see in a weird commercial, a short phrase of ambiguous meaning. It could also be taken as a caution, to make sure the timing is right before pursuing your dream. But knowing the context, to me it's a message of encouragement, and of urgency.

Some of our readers are aware--although others may not be (until now!)--that while VCMEC's 19th-century showplace now under renovation is in southwestern Michigan, the core VCMEC staff is currently working in Japan. We are funding the progress being made back home, but are not yet able to be there ourselves. We're grateful for the kind help of family and friends!

Since last issue, though, there have been some exciting developments. The biggest news is that a previously forgotten retirement fund, and the opportunity to have it as a lump sum, may make it possible to fast-track those renovations! Paperwork has been submitted and we'll know more soon.

It's usually difficult to get time off work in July, but this year the rare chance arose for a brief trip to the U.S., and I grabbed it to get to Lexington for the North American Model Horse Show Association's No NANsense event, featuring the A Good Vintage IV vintage custom showcase, and the opportunity to speak about VCMEC and distribute brochures about us and our mission! (Have you seen our nifty

new tri-fold brochure? It's available for download at vemee org and the VCMEC Facebook page!) It was wonderful beyond words to reconnect in person with hobby friends and equine heroes...but I tried to describe it in the report that starts on the next page!

(One experience that didn't make the report was revisiting the Walnut Hall Stud Cemetery at the Kentucky Horse Park, Back in 1992, during my time with Hoof Beats magazine, the KHP requested in-

formation on the cemetery and the greats who rest there, for new signage that was then being created. The eniovable task went to me--and there in the dappled shade 25 years later, it was moving to see that some of the text I'd

written is still on display.)

The trip's remaining days were in Michigan, working on the three-story VCMEC Hobby House & Museum (a peek at the front is below, while one morning's dawn as seen from the lobby is at left) and visiting family and friends. Thanks again

Many of the vintage customs bound for the Museum are currently in storage in Michigan, but quite a few are here in Japan. With North Korea's actions making for nervous days (news of their H-bombs, and the air-raid sirens and text messages to take cover when missiles are launched over Japan, have all on edge), and with the realization that if anything happens we won't be able to carry all the horses

A Good Vintage IV and More! Sparky C.'s Summer

Fun in Lexington



From model horse fun in steamy summers, to historic Grand Circuit harness racing when the maples turn to gold, Lexington has long been a place I've loved.



The day after judging in the 2000 BreyerFest Open show, though, I moved to Japan for a new job--and hadn't been able to get back to Kentucky ever since. This July, though, the planets were at last in alignment to allow a quick trip to the U.S., including three days in Lexington--just in time for Sarah Minkiewicz-Breunig's A Good Vintage IV

vintage custom showcase, part of the North American Model Horse Show Association's No NANsense event!



After flying in with a handcarried satchel of 14 vintage customs (mostly Classic size, and all survived the trip--but still, *not* recommended for their safety and your sanity!), I reached the Clarion Hotel Conference Center North on Tuesday and was tickled to see model horses already adorning room windows, signalling room sales.

One room had a wealth of original finish Breyer odds and ends, including a Hobo base I'd been needing. The sellers



were Terry and Antina Richards, who'd decided that after years of storage, it was time to part with what they explained were leftovers from Marney Walerius'

estate sale! Liz Isham Cory then walked in; she'd not only been at the sale but also has video footage from it! What a treat to hear their reminiscences. This would have made a fascinating oral history recording! I was also excited

to meet historian Nancy Kelly and say hey to Lois Bennington.

The next morning I visited with Karen Dietrich, who kindly

Genial genius Sue Rowe and her husband Todd had arranged to share my room that night, and were ready for fun even on the heels of their monster drive down to Kentucky. I had a great time tagging along for room shopping! Although few vintage customs turned up, it was interesting to note that one by a now-deceased artist was priced extra-high, while one by an artist whose name I was unfamiliar with was offered at



about body price-but I recognized the signature, and scored for the VCMEC Museum what was actually a work by Nancy Strowger!

There were so many joyous reunions in the halls, too! I was thrilled to see Susan Bensema-Young, Kim Bjorgo, Donna Chaney, Eleanor Harvey, Laurie Jo Jensen, Kay Myers, Kathleen Timmerman, and so

many more I'm spacing on--it's all one big giddy blur! Sue Rowe kindly shot photos of that wonderful time.

Thursday brought the main event, NAMHSA's No NANsense, at Rupp Arena. A Good Vintage IV lined a wall, with its five divisions--1960s-1970s (19 entries), 1980-84 (28 entries), 1985-89 (31), 1990-94 (17), and 1995-99 (10)--each allocated two long tables. The space quickly filled with a total of



105 entries, each with an info card or other documentation, and then Sarah and her staff--her husband, Chris, and her mother, Mom Mink--set a cup by each entry and passed out strips of voting tickets to attendees.

Each division's Top 10, Champions and Reserve Champions, the Overall Grand and Reserve

Grand Champions, and the winners in various other categories, received a wealth of gorgeous tile awards hand-crafted by Sarah...and yet the show was completely *free* to enter; that's how much Sarah loves vintage customs! 
Sarah also provided a lovely prize for me to

award on VCMEC's behalf. It went to Lakota Diamond, a CM Breyer Adios who appeared with documentation from artist Kathleen Maestas stating he was created around 1961-62. The fact the Adios mold was introduced in 1969 does not detract; it sums up the challenges faced in nailing down details about undated works as time flows on.

NAMHSA intended No NANsense to be "for the hobby to 'get back to its roots'--to provide a way for us to spend time with friends, learn from each other, and reminisce about

hobby history." Toward that end, VCMEC was given a table to distribute our brochures and chat with attendees, as well as time at the podium to speak about our mission. Thanks so much, NAMHSA!

The relaxed atmosphere let people hang out, catch up with old friends, and relive yesteryear leafing through the stacks of treasured photo albums brought by

Cheryl Monroe Remembers: Marney's Sale and Rehoming Her Herd

A quarter-century ago, our hobby lost one of its founders, Marney Walerius (shown at right at a 1971 Michigan backyard show). When the decision was made to disperse Marney's enormous collection in an estate sale, Cheryl Monroe of Michigan was one of the hobbyists that Stu Bentley asked to help, and the unsold remainder of Marney's huge herd of customized horses later came into her care. On this 25th anniversary of that epic sale, Cheryl shared her memories:

My, that was so long ago...Marney's sale came on the cusp of funerals--hers, my father- in-law's, and then her mother Elaine. There was so much to do!

I received a call from Mr. Bentley inquiring if I would be available to help with the seemingly insurmountable task of liquidating her collection at an estate sale held over a weekend! AND it was going to be in two WEEKS! Barely any notice, no time for a proper ad in hobby newsletters, how would we get the word out? I made a few calls, but was in the middle of dealing with my in-law's estate as well. Mr. Bentley put out a quick flyer that he mailed to hundreds of collectors. Unfortunately, many who would have liked to be there, didn't even find out about it until it was over.

Pam Young called me right about then, and she too was going, so we carpooled together and left the weekend before the sale to start the process. I was horrified to discover two BIG, FULL dumpsters had already left the property with TONS

of paper--how much hobby history had been in those dumpsters? Ah well, nothing could save that lot, onward to the task at hand...

We had a meeting between those of us there, and decided upon the plan of action. We did a FAST preliminary sort: OF Breyer, OF Other Plastic, OF China, Customs, and Tack & Props. I helped with the preliminary sort, and I did all the Tack & Props.It took ALL WEEK!


Sale weekend opened with sales at three locations: garage, basement, and front porch. The

garage was all Plastics, basement was Chinas & CMs, and porch was Tack & Props. I did the porch. Marney's brother Greg had told me at the beginning, don't bother with all that tack, just take it, but I KNEW it was worth something, so politely told him no, and he made over \$7,000 on the porch just Saturday. Sadly, that was about 1/5 the actual value. I brought home a bunch of tack no one wanted, too. During the auction, I sat up in front of the crowd helping to count the bids.

After the sale was over, we all went home, but Greg called me back two weeks later. He wanted to know if I would dispose of the 150+ CMs left over. I went home with much of her real horse tack as well, including English and Western saddles, and several bridles/halters. I found several other goodies after my husband Rodney assisted with moving Marney's dressers away from her second bedroom closet. Rescued SEVERAL photo albums and LOTS of show photos! Those photos helped identify several of the CMs I had left over that no one wanted, including approximately when they were created, via some of the dates on the photos. Many of these also had tags with the horse's name on them.

As a sidenote: Marney had other collections; Schnauzers, collector plates, dolls, and many original Beatles albums. I gave Greg info on these items and he called in another lady for the plates and dolls. He took the record albums back home with him for appraisal. The Schnauzers went into the sale, sadly many went unsold. What didn't sell at the horse sale that Terry Richards didn't want (she bought all the remaining OF stuff) I'm sure was donated, or disposed of when the house was prepared for sale.

I carefully packed up the remaining CMs, filled my van, and brought them home. This began the long, nostalgic selling off of the rest of MJW's customized treasures. Anything with recognition went right away, a signature or style got you out the door into a collector's hands. Each month I sent Greg the money, and after a few months he told me to just keep what was left. UNSIGNED things stayed here, AND all the unwanteds. MOST of the fixer-uppers stayed here too. They have been in a hold pattern in my black hole of a collection ever since!





On to the "rescues"!

Trying to match horses with artist/dates was arrived via asking the artist/s, or the piece was dated. Only ONE horse could not be identified and had no photo: Cutter's Pokey Pine. I have others as well, but they need some restoration work.

Empire's Fudge Sundae is a dark bay tobiano American Show Shetland stallion created from the Standing Stock Foal customized and signed Jason Ross/Ava Durbin, dated to 1984 from a photo I found. A "well-endowed" sassy little guy with attitude to spare! The only piece in my collection by this duo under Nancy Strowger's alter-ego, Jason Ross.





Rocking Chair Renegade Revel, a simple customized Adios, his name was on a name-tag on his leg, signed and dated 1979 (JR) by Jennifer Raymond, is a lovely detailed dark bay blanket Appaloosa stallion that is just gorgeous in person! He is very difficult to photograph.

Siri Snow Dotz is a loud black leopard Appaloosa gelding custom Lady Phase by another artist on my "would love to have by" list, Elizabeth Bouras. Liz thought he was maybe done around 1984. Not signed, but I DID find a photo that Marney had taken.





Diamond Fancy Cat, a drastic custom on the Stud Spider mold, created by Kathleen Maestas in 1978. He had

no mane/tail when I brought him home. No clue what happened to it OR the exact shade. He looked so nekkid without hair, so I put bright chestnut mohair on him when he got here in 1992.



lovely red chestnut Arabian mare customized from the Proud Arab Mare by Ray Ann Sneathen in 1990. Sadly, her filler is lifting on a few places, but she is still in one piece!

RAS Khatifa, a

Nisse AF Asgaard, his name was on his nametag, a custom Trakehner to a Knabstrup stallion by Fara Shimbo, she thought in 1985. JACKPOT! I always dreamed of a horse by Fara, and he is a GREAT ONE! I dearly LOVE this boy!





Encantador is a LOVELY Paso Fino gelding created on the El Pastor mold and signed by the late Karen Heinitz in 1984. Another grail for me! I wanted a piece by her for YEARS and this guy does not disappoint!

Turbo Twist--his name was on his photos--is a CM Hanoverian done to a grulla extreme frame overo Mustang stallion created by Sue Guffey in 1984. Unfortunately, he took a dive off my fireplace mantle to



the tile surround and lost an ear tip - his ONLY damage! Such a unique paint job, I just had to keep him!



Splasha Red, whose name was on his photos, is a chestnut tobiano Paint gelding done from the Stud Spider, created by Sue Guffey in 1985. He is another unusual pattern from her. I like the unusual, I quess! Katarina is a liver chestnut Appaloosa Knabstrup mare created on the Hanoverian mold, and signed/ dated by Lynn Baum in 1986. She has some damage that I think can be repaired, but I am leaving her as-is. One of Lynn's customs



with mohair instead of thread mane/tail.



Diamond Playtime--her name was on her photo by Chris Cook--is a cute little POA mare customized from a Classic Quarter Horse Stallion by Kathleen Maestas in 1978. A drastic change from standing to galloping! She is ADORABLE!

Tug Hill By Design, a John Henry painted dun by Ed Gonzales, is SIGNED: TO Marney from ED. I am amazed this piece was still here after all those who saw him. He is the "Marney" memento I get emotional over. He isn't a spectacular custom, but he is special for this reason.



SO Black River Hermes is a customized Justin Morgan in a red chestnut, and was signed by Sue Rowe in 1985. I was SO excited to see this fellow! I had only a foal by Sue at the time, and was happy to get this lovely!



LJ Powder's Rockette, signed by Laurie Jo Jensen, is a striking red roan Appaloosa mare created from the Stock Horse Mare. She has a gorgeous mixed hair mane and tail! I was thrilled to finally get something by LJJ!





Dun, a Stud Spider DRASTIC remake and signed by Ed Gonzales in 1988. This Nez Perce mare is another piece no one wanted as she does not stand up on her own. But there is just some-

thing about her that is endearing to me.

SO Supreme Threathis name was on his nametag--was created by Sue Rowe, in 1985 per Sue. This big boy was a Halla! A striking black Tennessee Walker stallion show stretched and stacked! Another grail piece for me! I was STUNNED he was still here!





Zip's Silver Lining is a custom Classic QH mare to a blue roan POA, created and signed (JAM) Janice Meixner in 1985. An understated little cutie that was another piece I couldn't resist!

Steeldust Lady's name and creator were on her name tag. She's a Lady Phase created by Cindy Derousseau in 1980. She is a VERY dappled grey QH mare, and is not going anywhere anytime soon!





Tug Hill Pied Piper, a Classic Arab Stallion custom to a trotting Morgan/Welsh cross by Chris Cook, from his photo by Chris Cook in 1984. This golden bay boy has a broken leg that Chris repaired, then it re-broke in transit BACK to me! Sigh... Hollywood Starlette is a buckskin QH mare, a Lady Phase CM by D'arry J Frank. I DID buy Hollywood Starlette outright, the weekend before the actual estate sale took place.

I had always wanted something D'arry Frank created but



could never afford it. I took a chance and asked D'arry one afternoon, in front of Marney's basement display case Starlette was in, how much, but she didn't want to put a price on her. D'arry said Starlette wasn't really her best work (read in 1992!)--but I talked her into selling anyways! A photo I found of her had a 1986 developing date on it. She could have been done a bit earlier, but by 1986 for sure. Marney had left the name tag on many of her CMs, which is how we determined WHO created them, and this horse was no exception. "Hollywood Starlette" was on her name tag, and a starlette she certainly is--I adore her!

Lastly, Cutter's Pokey Pine. A custom Lady Phase circa late '70s --1979 arbitrary date was chosen. Poor "Pine," unknown, unwanted, AND unloved--'til me! She is too cool to toss! A very unusual gal, from conversations online, I think she was a custom order to represent a real horse. But no idea WHO! I



could not for my life find ANY information on her, no photos, nothing. Her date is based on her paint job and she WAS re-haired sometime in the middle '80s--not well, I might add. But she is another I'm leaving as-is.

Cheryl helped many of Marney's now-vintage customs find appreciative homes with other hobbyists, too. Among those she sold in 1993-94 are these four future residents of the VCMEC Hobby House & Museum: Ante Up, Diamond Seonee, Nine Across, and RM Colorvision, Sparky C. writes:



A mid-'80s creation, Appaloosa gelding Ante Up is a Breyer Stock Horse Stallion remade standing by Sue Sudekum (who years later would design our VCMEC logo!). He still wears his nametag that Marney wrote and knotted around his ankle. A horse who's tough to beat in a game of "Name That Mold," Appaloosa stallion **Diamond Seonee** was the result of Kathleen Maestas remaking a--are you ready?--Breyer Indian Pony in the late 1970s. He's a dear favorite here!





The creator of unsigned Nine Across isn't yet known-but whoever they are, they can be proud of their artistry in transforming a standing Breyer Adios into this smooth-moving Paint stallion. Believed to have been done in the '80s, he has inset glass eyes.

We just missed RM Colorvision, a 1989 collaboration between Fara Shimbo (remake) and Julie Froelich (paint/hair), on one of Cheryl's saleslists--but this CM Breyer Hanoverian resurfaced on eBay in 2003, and is here to stay!



He was expensive, but I had some money saved and my parents floated me a bit of a loan for the rest.

"Back then we didn't know when a box would arrive, and I truly started to doubt that he would ever be mine. But he did arrive!

"I marveled over his exquisite face and all of the tiny details that Julie Froelich is known for. He was by far the most realistic 'R/H' model in my collection.

"Almaz Czar came with a beautiful set of show photos in every imaginable event, and I showed him in both English and western events at the live shows too, which also made him my first horse to so consistently bring home multiple ribbons.

"I wonder what I would have thought had I known that Almaz Czar would still be on my shelf, and that I would still be enjoying him, 33 years later?"

Soon after his arrival, I heard Royal Southern Brotherhood's song 'Moonlight Over The Mississippi' for the first time, and a phrase in it resonated so much, it became his name: Follow The Moonlight."

'As soon as you know what he started as,' I said, 'you'll recognize it: He started as a Breyer Justin Morgan.' 'Ohhh,' she slowly nodded, 'I see it now.' Gotta love vintage customs--back then, serious customs were serious CUSTOMS!"


