

We Are All Called and Gifted

St. Cecilia's Community Building Team (formerly Shared Ministry) is focusing on building community by identifying and calling out each person's gifts – our own and others. We believe this is in line with the USCCB document "Called and Gifted for the Third Millennium."

Each person has gifts and talents to contribute to the building up of family, community, church, and ultimately the Kingdom of God. St. Cecilia's would not be the vibrant parish that is if people didn't share their gifts of time and talent so generously. This weekend we would like to take some intentional time to think about what gifts we have and how we might be able to use them in service to our mission. Rather than our traditional ministry signup, we will focus on Harvesting Our Gifts by naming our own gifts, naming gifts others have affirmed in us, naming our experience and interests (which are not necessarily the same) and how/if we are able to use them at this time.

One goal is to create a database of gifts and talents so when there are specific needs, we can match the right gifts with the right ministry. This seems to be a more effective way to do ministry rather than desperately begging people to fill slots. With that in mind, we will still have signups for various events throughout the year, but they will be more specific in nature.

Another important goal is to build community by getting to know each other better. We are a parish of choice – people choose to come here for a variety of reasons, and one important reason is the sense of community we experience. This happens in a variety of ways: through liturgy, through formation, through outreach opportunities and through socializing. Our hope is that through the next year people will get to know each other a little better and together we will come to a deeper understanding of who we are and what we hope to be.



Six moms and 14 children blessed our lives as we served healthy snacks, read to, laughed and played with the children. Thanks to Stephanie Hanson, we even treated the moms to foot soaks and massaged their tired feet one evening. We were able to return to our homes but these families are still there. Fortunately, with the help of Project Home and Interfaith Action of Greater St. Paul, they are being helped to access services to assist them to move on. There were 7.668 homeless men, women and children in Minnesota in 2017, up 4.6% from 2016! We can help to change the root causes that prevent so many from having a safe place to live. Let's challenge our legislators, and those currently seeking office, to work hard to make affordable housing a priority. Thank you again volunteers!
