Thanksgiving is a <u>federal holiday</u> in the United States, celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November.^[1] It is sometimes called **American Thanksgiving** (outside the United States) to distinguish it from <u>the Canadian holiday</u> of the same name. It originated as a <u>harvest festival</u>, and to this day the centerpiece of Thanksgiving celebrations remains <u>Thanksgiving dinner</u>. The dinner traditionally consists of foods and dishes indigenous to <u>the Americas</u>, namely <u>turkey</u>, <u>potatoes</u> (usually <u>mashed</u>), stuffing, squash, <u>corn</u> (maize), <u>green beans</u>, <u>cranberries</u> (typically in <u>sauce form</u>), and <u>pumpkin pie</u>. Thanksgiving is regarded as being the beginning of the fall–winter <u>holiday season</u>, along with <u>Christmas</u> and the <u>New Year</u>, in American culture.
