Present: Schwab, Kertis, Goska, Raasch and Zimmerman.  
Chairperson Schwab called meeting to order at 7:05pm.

**Motion: (Kertis, Schwab) Move to approve Operator Licenses for Antlers Archers as listed: Michael Soik, Michael Bohn, Scott Walker, Bruce Kramer, Gary Martin, Richard See, Kevin Garrigan, Thomas Bohn, Tracy Van Asten, David Hanneman, Wesley Johnson. Carried. Unanimous Ayes.**

**Applications for P.T. Grader Operator:** The Board Members reviewed the P.T. Grader Operator application on file from David Feit, Louis Rozner and Dale Winkler. Schwab will check to see if applicants are still interested in employment and see about setting up interview times.

**Budget Sheet and Financials:** Raasch asked if anyone had questions concerning May Reconciliation. May Receipts total \$26,073.90. Zimmerman gave out hard copies of Budget Sheet as of May 31, 2010.

**Motion: (Schwab, Goska) Accept Financial Report for audit. Carried. Unanimous Ayes.**

The Board Members and any residents wishing to follow went on Site Reviews at following locations:

**Parking Complaints: South Park Drive:** Baseball League will work with Town to have more parking available. At site it was suggested by Marvin Raasch to take out trees along Southside of road, same as what is there for a short distance and to angle park on property. Wisconsin Rapids School Board will have to be notified if trees can be removed on property. This would be done to the end of school property (backside of ball diamond). There would also be No Parking on North side of South Park Drive, which would eliminate children running across street to get to baseball diamond.

**Angle Road/Birch Drive:** Board Members met with Town Residents that live on Angle and Birch. Below are some concerns and/or information received:

- Truck traffic on Angle Drive: Okray Farms, Zblewski Brothers, McCains
- Water hole by County F, Angle Road, Birch Drive when heavy rains, early Spring
- Marv Raasch- Angle should be pulverized-hot mix overlay
- Kertis- Hot Mix \$42,000.00 project; cold mix overlay for \$18,000.00
- Overlay Angle (County F-just past Dennis Higgins driveway)
- Angle Road was the short cut from Plover to Kellner years ago
- Culvert needs to come out by Higgins Homestead (not functional)


**Mertz Subdivision & Juniper Lane/Court:** Struck & Irwin Paving, Inc. did a poor job with prep work for Slurry Sealing cracks. Manager called and Slurry Sealing can't be finalized until Board Members approve prep work. Cracks on Arbor Lane and Spruce Lane not filled properly.

**100th Street/Mill Road:** After discussion decided that both ends of Mill Road 1/4 mile from 100th St and 1/4 mile from County F should be pulverized as long as equipment is in area doing 100th St.

**Motion: (Schwab, Goska) Ask for a work change order from American Asphalt to pulverize both ends of Mill Road and 100th Street and put base course on 100th St. Carried. Unanimous Ayes.**

**Motion:(Goska, Kertis) Move to adjourn at 9:30pm. Carried. Unanimous Ayes.**
