WHAT IS THE NEURO CLINIC?

The Neuro Clinic is a **FREE** 8-week physical therapy clinic for persons with neurological disabilities. Weekly sessions are conducted by second year DPT students with PT faculty supervision.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any adult with a neurological diagnosis who has physician permission is welcome.

WHEN IS THE NEURO CLINIC?

The Neuro Clinic will be on Tuesday afternoons for 8 weeks from August 20th through October 8th. Each session will run for two hours. Sessions run from **1:00 - 3:00pm.**

WHERE IS THE NEURO CLINIC?

The Neuro clinic is located on the campus of Rosalind Franklin University at 3333 Green Bay Rd in North Chicago, IL.

WHAT ARE SOME PROGRAM SPECIFICS?

You will work with a small group of two to four 2nd year Doctor of Physical Therapy students supervised by licensed Physical Therapist faculty members. The students will conduct a physical therapy assessment on the first session and then work with you to develop goals and a treatment plan to meet the goals over the course of the remaining sessions.
