All producers supplying “fed cattle” to Tyson must be BQA certified after January 1, 2019.

The Indiana BQA training program includes cow-calf, stocker, and feedlot elements to ensure that “all beef producers” will have the credentials to market animals in the future as more processors incorporate the BQA requirement. BQA certification is free and approximately 2 hours in length. Producers selling fed cattle through an auction market that supplies cattle to either Tyson or National Beef will need to have a copy of their BQA certificate and BQA number on file at the auction market.
