Ash Wednesday: The Archdiocese of Cincinnati sent a recent update to Pastors regarding the manner in which ashes will be distributed on Ash Wednesday as a precautionary measure in a time of public health concern. In accordance with a recent instruction issued by the Holy See, the Priest, along with any other lay distributors, will sprinkle ashes on the head of each person without saying anything and without imposing ashes on the forehead. The archdiocesan update also issued the reminder that ashes "may not be self imposed; they are always given by a minister," and the "wearing of ashes, while customary and laudable, is not an obligation of the faithful, so anyone who is fearful of becoming sick should not come forward, or even come to Mass on Ash Wednesday."

<u>Collection for Central and Eastern Europe</u> will be taken up on Ash Wednesday. This collection supports the Church in more than 25 countries that still struggle to recover from former communist rule. Funds from this collection support pastoral care, catechesis, building renovations, and seminary formation. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the collection.
