Information for New Castle Invitational Rodeo with Ohio

Check-In: Friday Evening, 6-8 pm **Face covering is required for check-in**
Saturday Morning, 7-8 am **(must be checked in by 8 am)**

Saturday, April 24: **Shoot:** 8 am (leave from Cox's trailer at 7:30 am)
Contestant Meeting: 8:30 am, Arena bleachers **(Face covering is required)**
Slack: 10 am
Performance: 7 pm

Sunday, April 25: **Cowboy Church:** 8 am, Arena bleachers
One long go: 9 am - **All JH events will run first; with the HS events to start after JH is completed.**

Entries will be accepted by email or text only. Scan and email the completed entry form to inhsrarodeoentries@gmail.com or text a picture of the completed entry form to 765-717-5775. Deadline for entries will be **April 14** at 5 pm. NO entries will be accepted after that date. Once the position draw is completed (probably April 21) it will be emailed to each contestant.

This rodeo will count as two separate rodeos for Indiana and Ohio HS and Ohio JH. However, this is the State Finals rodeo for Indiana JH, so it will be treated as one rodeo with points being allotted for two go rounds, an average, and bonus points (plus points being carried in to state finals from best seven season rodeos).

On Friday night, the Indiana student officers will be in charge of warm-ups for poles and barrels. The cost will be \$5. A flyer with more information is included.

On Saturday, we will run slack starting at 10am and performance at 7pm with both JH and HS contestants. On Sunday, we will run slack starting at 9am and run **ALL of the JH contestants first**. By doing this, we will be able to start calculating the Indiana JH points for State Finals winners. The HS (both Indiana and Ohio) will start their competition after the JH is completed.

There will be a shoot on Saturday morning for both high school and junior high contestants. This will be the state finals shoot for Indiana contestants. The shoot will start at 8:00 am, at the Monroe Township Conservation Club, 2400 CR 700 S, Muncie, IN 47302. Contestants should meet Jeremy Byers at Stephanie Cox's (rodeo secretary) trailer and be ready to leave at 7:30 am. To enter the shooting, it is listed under the payment section of the entry form.

No ground fires will be allowed. If the Saddle Club catches anyone with a ground fire, there will be a \$200 fine. Fires will be allowed in raised fire pits.

There is a soccer field located on a hill at the south end of the camping facilities, **NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED ON THAT FIELD!!!**

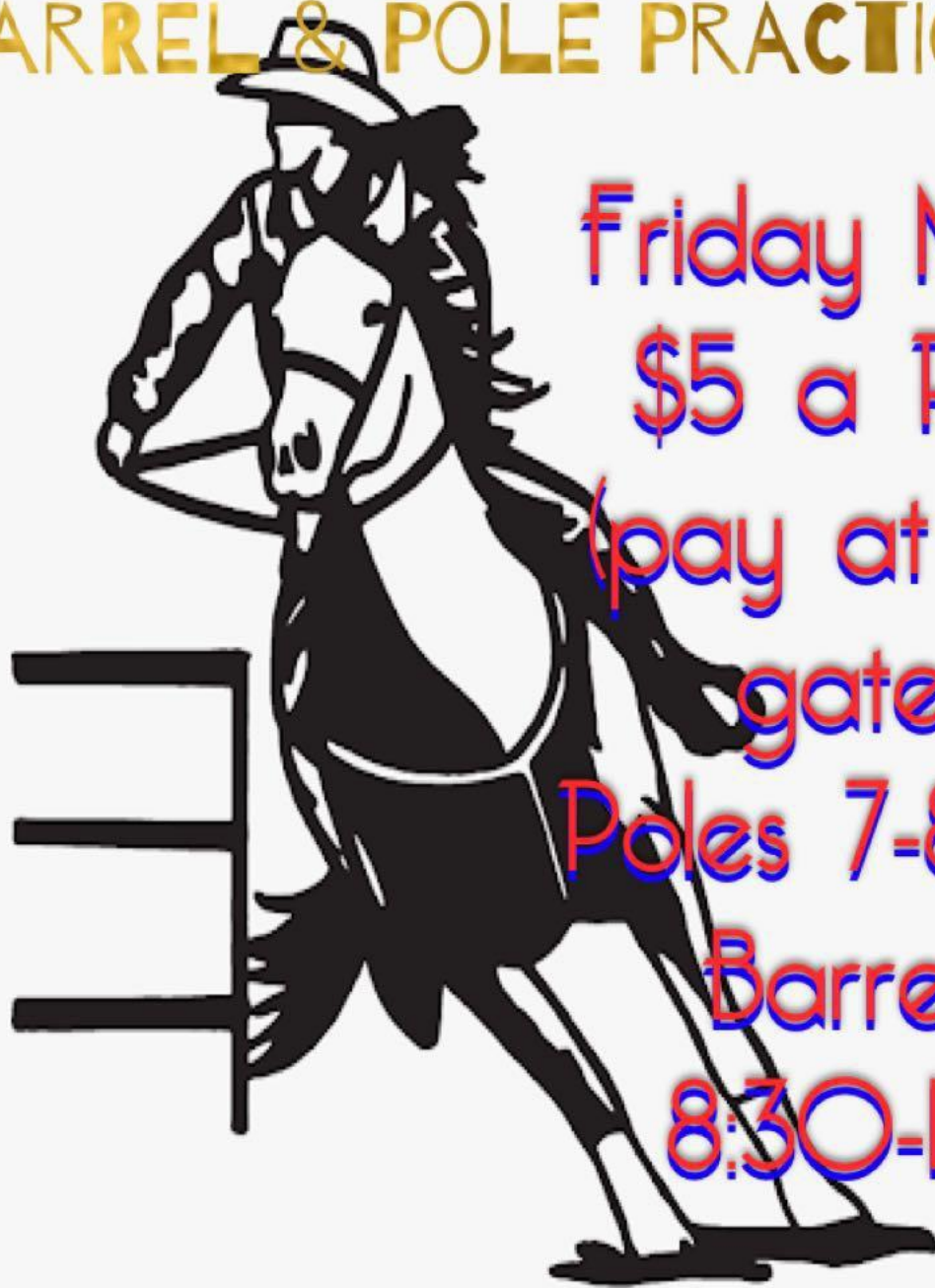
Stalls are mandatory and only one horse per stall. Absolutely no tie-outs, tack and go only. Once entries have been received, we will assign stalls. Stall cost for the weekend is \$45. Shavings will be available at \$6 per bag. You are expected to keep stalls picked during the weekend; however, when you leave the saddle club will strip the stalls.

Camping with electric is \$45 for the weekend and is first come, first serve. (There are 216 - 20 amp, 165 - 30 amp and 34 - 50 amp, so there should be plenty of camping.) There are water hookups available, but you may need to bring a splitter and long hose, as they are not all close.

Ohio Members – Please do NOT pay the scholarship fund fee shown on the HS entry form, as this is for Indiana HS members only.
