



The Charlotte Aeromodelers Club was founded in 1972 by a group of individuals who build, fly and enjoy all types of radio controlled aircraft from electric, to gliders, to giant scale. Our flying field (McCracken Aerodrome) is located in Union County about 14 miles east of Mint Hill, and just 900' north of the NC218 / NC200 intersection. The GPS address for our driveway is 8613 Morgan Mill Rd., Monroe, NC.



Our first class facility consists of 5 acres of unobstructed land. It is one of the finest sites in the Southeast and allows us to host a wide variety of events each year. We have electricity available at our shelters with charging shelves, and a 24-hour weather station so you can check the conditions at the field from your home or mobile device. In addition to our 600' x 125' grass runway, we also have a dedicated flight line for helicopters, quadcopters, and 3D aircraft.



We are sanctioned by the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA), a national organization that promotes sport aviation, and we are an AMA-recognized Gold Leader Club, an honor conferred on us for exemplary achievement, charitable giving, and community involvement.

We are family friendly, alcohol-free, and have play facilities for the young ones, a covered pavilion with rocking chairs where spouses can relax, and a large flying area. We also have an enclosed kitchen prep area for those times we prepare meals, such as our Events and our summer season club meetings at the field.

We welcome visitors to come and watch us fly and share the joy and excitement of this hobby. Feel free to ask questions about anything you see and if you like what you see, we always welcome new members. We would love to meet you and swap those big flying stories.



Contact one of the officers and let us know you are coming and we will give you a big Charlotte Aeromodelers welcome to fly as a guest, BUT...you must be an AMA member, obey the Club's posted safety rules, and be accompanied by your Club Contact. We have several flight instructors that can help you with everything from building your *first model*, to *breaking-in* a new engine, to getting you to your first solo flight. We even have a trainer airplane you can use to get the feel of piloting.

Our monthly club meetings are held on the first Wednesday of every month at 7pm. During the winter months (Nov.— Apr.) we meet at Jimmie's Restaurant in Mint Hill and during the summer flying season (May— Oct.) we meet at the field. Come for dinner at 6pm, if you wish, at your cost at Jimmie's. Free burgers or hot dogs at 6pm when we meet at the field.
