

**City of New Munich**

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall. Jim Poepping, Shawn Duevel, Ron Doll, Bryan Kasten and Pat Nathe were present.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Pat Nathe and carried the minutes from Sept 2018 were approved.

Allen Fielder was present to inform the Council of 4 medical call for the past month. 1 CO alarm. New Rescue Rig is in service, as the City is a property owner to the burn location, we need to write a letter to ok the burn. Daniel Thomas is a new fire fighter that has started this month. Tom is starting to prep for winter, he discharged the north pond. Tom asked if Roger Boeckers could clean the lift stations for winter.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Bryan Kasten and carried the building permit for Gail Wieling, Josh Poepping and Jeff Nathe were approved.

Steve Soyka was there to present, he is running for Stearns County Sheriff.

Roger Boeckers would like to stake out the 250 Liberty Property, he recommends that a council member/mayor to go with him, Jim would like the pits filled for safety reasons. Roger mentioned a man hole is needed and Roger is going to get a price for the road to the development. Test wells for State of MN are located on the property, Tom will call the state to verify the wells.
