SHOW RULES:

- For Warm Up Show-Casual attire, horses need not be clipped or bathed.
- Negative Coggins required and horses coming over Illinois state line require Health Certificates.
- Safety helmets are required for all English classes. Helmets are always highly <u>recommended</u> in all classes at K-D. Boots are required. Show committee has final decision on any changes or disputes.
- Circle K-D or its members are not responsible for ANY injury or loss of property. Ride at your own risk.
- Riders must register and pay class fees before they are added to a class. No refunds on fees.
- ALL CIRCLE KD SAFETY RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND MUST BE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES!!
- Classes may be cancelled or combined.
- No Stallions allowed on Circle KD grounds.
- Only one horse/rider combo per class.
- This show was designed to be fun, reasonable priced and to teach or school either horse or rider for the upcoming show season.
- A qualified Circle K-D person will judge and manage timed events.

Novice Class (if applicable):

- A Novice Rider is defined as an individual who has NOT won 2 first place classes in one calendar year.
- These classes are designed for beginner riders regardless of age, not horses.
- Novice riders are allowed in novice walk trot, novice horsemanship, novice pleasure, Trail, 4-H, and speed classes.
- It is at the judges discretion if a rider is too experienced for this class. These are the steps that will be taken:
 - 1. He or she will judge the class and place according to the rider's abilities.
 - 2. After the results of the class have been turned into the announcer, the judge will ask the rider to transfer to the higher-level classes.
 - 3. The rider will forfeit any points from the previous class that were being accumulated towards the high point award.

Lead Line:

- Judging will be based on the rider's ability to control and steer the horses themselves.
- The lead person is there for safety in case a horse gets out of control.

Class Fees:

- Please not that class fees are due when you sign up at the booth. A card for each class must be completed and fees paid for each horse and rider combination.
- If you ride all day, a deposit is required in the form of a blank check made out to Circle K-D. At the end of the day your
 classes are totaled and the check is finalized.
- You or a member of your family may transfer to another class (in advance).
- There are no refunds.
