## COVID Questions and In-Person

Sorry, it took me so long to get these answers. I just met with Dustin on Friday.

1. If we are waiting 90 days to get the vaccine because we recently had COVID, is the district going to schedule us when the time is right? **No, you can schedule your appointment yourself by going to the St. Mary's website or this [link:https://coronavirus.providence.org/blog/uf/647143738](https://coronavirus.providence.org/blog/uf/647143738)**
2. After today, everyone who wanted a vaccine has been scheduled and received one. **Anyone who changes their mind and wants one will have to schedule it themselves at the link above.**
3. Are Subs going to be given the opportunity to get the vaccines if they want? **Yes, they were sent an email last week and allowed to book appts.**
4. Is the vaccine mandatory? **No, as of right now, the district is allowing teachers to choose whether to take it or not. Around 66% of members have chosen to get vaccinated.**
5. COVID Test: **It will be mandatory if you are an in-person member or plan to step foot on campus every two months per the waiver plan. You don't have to get it with the District, you just have to get one and give the results to the district. We will wait and see how often based on what the CDC says and if the district takes advantage of the extra money and follows the Human and Health Services Guidelines.**
6. Do we know when we will start in-person instruction back? **I asked admin today. They do not have a date set. They are hoping to have a date set this week. Please do not plan more than a week at a time for online instruction. The district usually gives us a week or two notice, but just in case. We will stay on the hybrid model and unfortunately 7-12 do**
