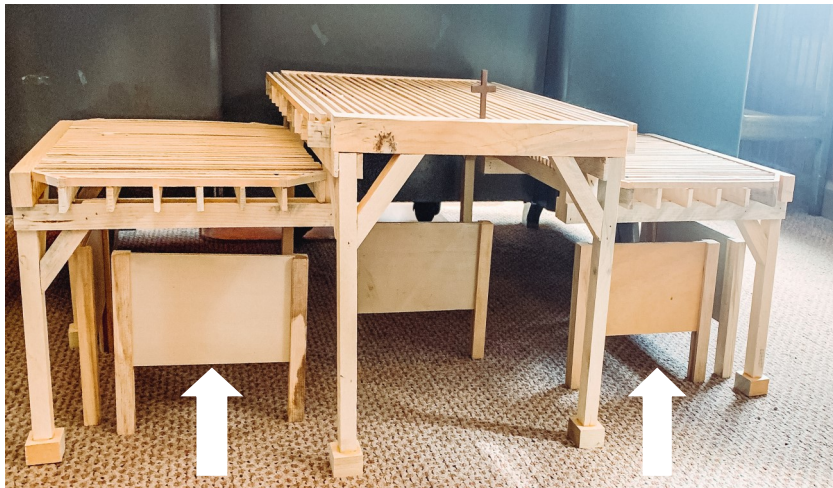


EL SANTUARIO DE LOS POBLADORES- DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY.

Update on Santuario Shrine

Work will continue on the Santuario shrine as soon as weather permits, hopefully sometime in April. The last quadrant housing the 4th Mystery of the Rosary (The Resurrection) only lacks about three more weeks of steady work which would include cement for capping, sand and labor costs. Our committee is meeting periodically to discuss fundraising efforts as well as offering ideas /suggestions on the best methods to display the adobe dedication plaques, merchant plaques, landscaping, placement of the mission statues and last but not least, the 7 ft. statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This week's display is an idea for housing the adobe dedication plaques... the one seen here, but on a much larger scale, would be constructed of wood with an overhead covering to offer protection for the names. Kneelers and benches are also needed for the nichos. Volunteers who have offered their services in contacting area parishioners for mission statue donations are Lorene Quintana— St. Augustine Mission in Antonito; Elliott Salazar— La Sagrada Familia-Lobatos, Lorraine Atencio—San Rafael Mission, Guillermo DeHerrera—San Isidro in Las Mesitas with Bert DuPont also helping and David Mondragon & Family—San Miguel Mission.

Help is still needed with San Antonio mission and Ortiz mission. Some additional donations are still needed for the St. Augustine Mission in Antonito.

El Santuario is an open-air structure shaped as a traditional labyrinth. As the oldest parish in Colorado with baptismal records beginning in 1858, Our Lady of Guadalupe was already a historical site. El Santuario builds upon this legacy. El Santuario group is a committee of Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish.

MASS READING REFLECTION

FIRST READING

1 Sm 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a
[The Lord's Anointed]

The readings of Lent have a baptismal character as we are preparing for a renewal of our baptismal commitment to God at Easter. Two elements of this reading throw light on baptism: (1) God's free choice: God chose the youngest son of Jesse, not the others: "There anoint him, for this is the one!" (2) The meaning of the baptismal anointing: Priests, prophets, and kings were anointed. Especially the kings were seen as the "Lord's anointed" -Messiah- Christ. Anointed to royal dignity, the king was viewed as God's adopted son with "the spirit of the Lord..... upon" him.

At baptism, the anointing with chrism brings out our royal dignity as adopted children of God. God chose you! It is not the other way around. You share God's life and are filled with the Spirit through baptism. Be appreciative!

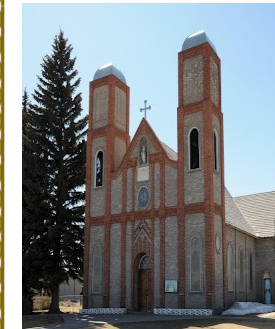
SECOND READING

Eph 5:8-14

[Children of Light]

"You are light in the Lord" through faith sealed with baptism. It is a basic human symbol: light as good and darkness as evil. "Live as children of light." Take a stand, as suggested in the theme. It concerns the Christian life-style: "goodness and righteousness and truth" as opposed to "the fruitless works of darkness." Lent should wake us up, make us aware of what we should be as Christians. "Awake, O sleeper!"

Fourth Sunday of Lent



THEME: FAITH AND UNBELIEF.

We are often asked to take a stand, be it concerning politics, the education of the children, or the way work should be done. Taking a stand, especially one concerning a controversial issue, may involve opposition. Christians are asked to take a stand quite often. In today's Gospel the writer of John brings out a wealth of suggestions.

Let us consider one. How do people react to our Lord's message? Christianity offers beautiful and efficient outlines for a better society with promises for life to come. Christianity is not something one can sweep under the rug and ignore as nonexistent. It is there! One must take a stand.

The Gospel shows us the parents of the blind man (who do not want to be involved), the neighbors (who are indifferent), the Pharisees (who do not believe), and the blind man himself (a believer). Where do you stand? You are a baptized Christian. Does the Lord Jesus and the philosophy of life he stands for have real impact on your lifestyle?

Each of the four categories mentioned in the Gospel is found in today's society. Each promotes its own outlook by work and life-style. You must take a stand.
