BY LAWS OF THE APOSTOLIC FAITH BIBLE COLLEGE, INC.

Article VII Doctrine

It is recognized that the true church of Jesus Christ consists of all believers who believe in the saving grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and who have accepted Him as their personal Savior. It is recognized and agreed that no organization or man has been granted authority by the Lord to exclude from or accept anyone into the Kingdom of Heaven, as this is done by Jesus Christ only. It is further recognized and agreed that we as Christians are to love all members of the Body of Christ (Christians), and this love and fellowship derives from the unity instilled by the Holy Spirit. Although differences in doctrinal beliefs and interpretations should not influence our love for one another. adherence to similar doctrinal beliefs and modes of worship have bonded together those of the Apostolic Faith Movement as founded by Charles F. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. The common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as follows.

- * Triune God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- * Creation and Formation
- * Man is basically sinful and in need of salvation
- * Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Savior, which is the conception of Spiritual Life
- * Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul, and Body, A second definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ
- * Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by the speaking in other languages.
- * Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit
- * Sacrament of the Lord's Supper
- * Washing of feet
- * Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers
- * Do not condone divorce and remarriage
- * Destruction of the wicked
- * Conditional Immortality
- * Rapture of the Man Child Class
- * Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly
- * A ministry supported by tithes and offerings

These doctrines shall be adhered to in the teachings of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teaching approved by the Board from time to time if they are not inconsistent with the above listed basic doctrines.





Bringing Light to Turkey

Arise, shine, for your light has come, and three glory of the Lord rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you. nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. Isaiah 60:1-3

Turkey is a country filled with history, especially Biblical history. Mount Ararat in Eastern Turkey is considered to be the resting place of Noah's Ark.

Much of the work done by Paul was done in Turkey, in cities such as Ephesus. The Isle of Patmos where John received the Revelation is off the coast of Turkey. All of the seven churches of Revelation are in modern day Turkey. John is buried near Ephesus in Selcuk. When Constantine declared Christianity the official religion and persecution ceased, he moved the capital to Constantinople, modern day Istanbul, which also became the center of the church before Rome.

Yet within a country with so much history, there are very few people in the nation of Turkey that know the Truth. In fact, in Turkey, there are only approximately 2000 national believers in Jesus Christ. The nation declares freedom of religion but still persecutes the Church. It is against the law to try to spread the Gospel. By percentage, the Turkish people are the most unreached people group in the world. Over 98% of the people are Muslim. The nation is a very dark place.

I recently was privileged to travel to Turkey. Since the nation is still very closed off, our goal was to make friends with Turkish people and pray for the people as we traveled.

During the beginning of the trip, we arrived in the largest city of Turkey, Istanbul. We spent the first couple of days just getting used to our surroundings, prayer walking and talking to as many English speaking Turks as we could. Fortunately, we discovered very quickly that the Turkish people are very friendly and are very eager to make friends.

Our original plans had been to go to Izmir from Istanbul, but God led the team to skip the city of Izmir and the work we had planned to do there to go on to Selcuk. We were supposed to meet with a Christian team and help them with events they were coordinating. We found out about a week later that the team we were supposed to meet up with had been arrested.

We spent about 9 hours on a bus traveling to Selcuk, a small town near Ephesus. We saw a lot of amazing things happen in Selcuk. Since it is away from the craziness of the big city, the people are much more down to earth and love to just sit and talk which led for many opportunities to tell them about the love of Christ. The people, although all Muslim, were eager to hear what we had to say.

During one day of the trip, we got to go with a missionary that lived in Selcuk to visit believers across the countryside. What we did that day was very dangerous. We would stop on the side of the road when we saw someone, talk to them, and give them a Bible.

We met a couple of families of believers. Their lives truly touched me. These people have no church and no other friends they can contact to talk about God with. They only have their own family and the Bible. They will spend 4-5 hours a day in the Word. The only other contact they have with Christians is when the missionary can come by which isn't very often as to not be suspected by the government.

During the trip, we did see one person come to Jesus! The fact that we know of one person that came to Jesus because of our work there was worth the entire trip!

As we left Selcuk, we had the opportunity to get Bibles and Jesus films into the hands of the many friends we had made throughout our time there. God only knows how that has affected their lives.

We spent our last days in Turkey back in Istanbul. Even during shopping, we got the opportunity to share with shop owners on the street. Our group started talking to one carpet shop owner and as we were talking, other people kept coming closer and sitting near to get to listen to the things we were telling them about God.

I felt so blessed to have this opportunity. Thank you to all of you who supported me in this trip and prayed for me during the time I was there!

Please continue to pray for the people of Turkey. Pray that their hearts would be open to know Jesus. Also, pray for boldness in the national believers that they would not be afraid to become witnesses.

Jenny is employed at Super Clips Beauty Salon and Brian works at Forall Bible Book Store. They are making their home in Joplin, MO.






Do you remember the time when the Lord began to dig in the hardness of your

new foundation, just like the new building would need, to support it when it would be completed.






it would soon be ready to build upon. Every day we could see the progress that those


It was so exciting the day that the building started going up. We watched as the anchors were placed in the concrete - again to give the

There were times that the workers needed a break - time to refuel and rest awhile- just as we need to rest in the Lord and refuel our inner man for the labor ahead.




Finally the outside was beginning to look like a building- but it's not done
