PARSONS – The Mt. Lions Baseball team hosted Pendleton County on Wednesday April 26th. Tucker County got down in the 1st inning and never recovered as they fell in the contest 16-1.

Pendleton County took the lead in the 1st inning on a double and 3 singles. The Wildcats then added 7 runs in the 4th inning off a double and 2 singles. Cameron Wamsley took the loss on the mound for Tucker County. Garrett Carrico led the Mt. Lions with 2 hits on 3 at bats and Cameron Wamsley, Christian Purnell and Michael Gherman each had 1 hit in the Tucker County loss.

Tucker County hosted Trinity Christian the same night Wednesday April 26th in Game 2 of a double header and the Mt. Lions got the victory 12-1. Shayne Liller started the game with a bang as Liller connected with a home run in the 1st inning and Liller also added a single in the 1st inning also. Garrett Carrico and Christian Purnell also singled in the 1st inning. Michael Gherman earned the win for Tucker County as he struck out 7 batters and allowed just 1 run. The Mt.
