In the village

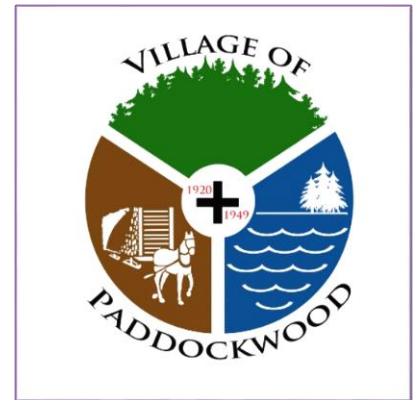

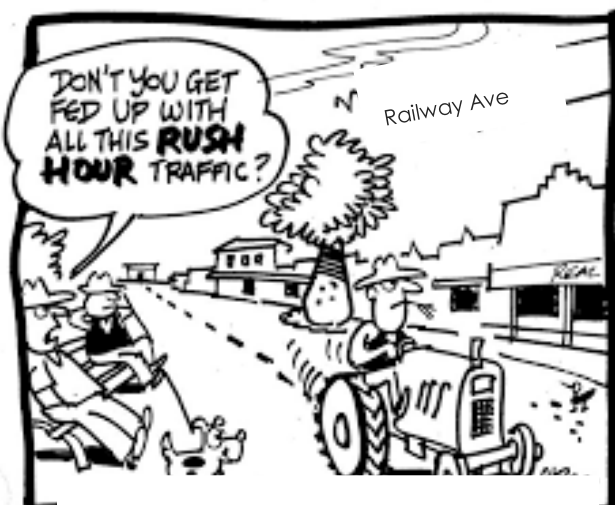
