

GRAND OAKS FARM Red Pine Hunter-Jumper Horse Show

August 27th & 28th, 2022

RPHSA is excited to host the fifth show of the 2022 season at Grand Oaks Farm in Delano, MN.

Here are a few important things to know.

VACCINATIONS & COGGINS: ALL horses are required to have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and EHV vaccination within the past 6 months. You must bring a copy of both to the show office before unloading your horse. If you showed at a prior 2022 Red Pine show, please confirm with office they have your horse's records on file.

ENTRIES close August 22nd, or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

Arrival- please do not arrive on the farm before 6:30am each show day.

STABLING- *IMPORTANT* If you need a stall, you must email or text Missy 763-350-9237 Any riders with a stall must be registered at horseshowsonline.com by August 18th in order to keep your stall. Stabling is VERY limited; priority will be given to entries traveling long distances.

Cost of stabling on Saturday and Sunday is \$65/day (1 bags of shavings is required). Friday overnight is additional \$30; horses cannot arrive before Friday at 2pm when Friday schooling opens.

SHOW RINGS & SCHEDULE (subject to change, depending on # of entries)

Full schedule is available at HorseShowsOnline.com.

Two show arenas: (1) **Main** outdoor sand ring, (2) **Indoor** sand ring. One outdoor schooling sand arena (140x70).

SATURDAY HUNTERS:

Walk-trot and crossrails will be held in indoor arena. Main Ring will hold all 2 ft to 3 ft classes up to 3'. Due to time constraints, there will not be a warm-up class offered for any division which offers hunter and equitation (ie beginners, pre-children/adult, open). Crossrail warm-up is only open to riders doing ONE of two crossrails divisions. If you are doing both crossrail divisions, you are not eligible for crossrail warm-up.

SUNDAY JUMPERS:

Crossrail and .65m classes will be held in **Indoor** arena. The 0.75m and up will be in **Main** outdoor ring.

SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON ENTRIES

Schooling should be available each morning before show- rings open at 7:00am; rings close 30 min before classes begin in each ring. Schooling during show will be available in designated arena---see Farm map.

Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

CLASSES

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 81 or 91) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 181), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class in order to be eligible for prize money. Horseshowsonline is Hunters=Class 500SAT and Jumpers=Class 501. More info can be found at <http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html>

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for a stake class.

FEES

Stall fees- see STABLING section above. Shavings \$9/bag. No hay is available.

Office fee- \$25 per horse

Friday schooling per horse \$25 from 2-6pm.

Classes- \$25 per hunter/equitation class; \$35 per jumper class; special classes vary and will be posted at www.horseshowsonline.com

MISCELLANEOUS

Food will be available onsite Saturday and Sunday.

No camping onsite unless you have a generator and can park at the very back of the property.

Method of payments include: Credit card (3.5% fee), cash or check.
