




CATECHISM: Classes began on Sept. 22nd and will be held every 2 weeks. You must register your children and bring a copy of their baptism certificates. Please email: olom.education@gmail.com or call 506-531-0252. For those not baptized yet, please bring a copy of their birth certificates for our files. We will welcome children of all ages. Preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation, First communion and Confirmation for 12yrs and over, starts in a few weeks! All children have to be baptized and supply proof of baptism at the beginning of the sessions. Younger children under 6 may also listen and participate in the sessions but they need to be in grade one for the first sacraments. The catechism program is an engagement by parents to accompany their children in the education program as well as attending the weekly mass that follows the sessions! We lead by example always and our children learn from their parents, first and foremost!
