ROE V. WADE Questions and Answers

So ROE allows states to prohibit abortion after viability?

Well, no. In the companion case *Doe v. Bolton*, which the Court said must be read together with *Roe*, “health” was defined in the abortion context to include: “all factors—physical, emotional, psychological, familial, and the woman’s age—relevant to the well-being of the patient.” By this definition, abortion must be allowed in the ninth month if the abortionist says it is needed to serve a woman’s emotional well-being. Though the modern court has yet to confront a challenge to a post-viability ban, *Doe* suggest that no meaningful limits can be placed on abortion throughout the nine months of pregnancy.

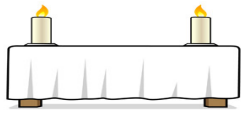
