

## **Video Lesson 3- Attitude 1: Don't Make Assumptions (4:54)**



### **GAME ACTIVITY**

Pause the video at 00:33 and play the following GAME:

Split the class into groups of 4. Then ask the pupils to jot down the first 3 things that pop into their head when you say a particular word. Before you start, tell the pupils not to overthink it. There are no wrong answers. They must jot down whatever pops into their head in response to the word you say.

When everyone is ready with pen in hand, ask the pupils to write down the first 3 things that pop into their heads when you say the word: WORK.

When they are finished, ask them to see if they have a match within their group. For it to be a match, everyone in the group must have written the same word. Once the groups have finished checking if they have a match, see how many groups had a match and share the results with the class.

Now repeat the instructions for the next word and ask the pupils to write down the first 3 things that pop into their heads when you say the word: LOVE.

Again, ask the groups to see if they have a match once everyone has finished jotting down their thoughts. Remind the pupils that everyone in the group must have the same word written down in order for it to be considered a match. Then finally repeat the instructions one final time and ask the pupils to write down the first 3 things that pop into their heads when you say the word: PICNIC. Again, ask the groups to see if they have a match once everyone has finished jotting down their thoughts. Remind the pupils that EVERYONE in the group must have the SAME word written down in order for it to be considered a match. Discuss what they think the game is trying to highlight.
