Welcome

President Wetzler welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Chaparral Principal

She welcomed Dr. Chomokos, Principle of Chaparral High School and her staff to provide a brief overview of the high school to parents. She and her staff spoke about academics, athletics and the guidance counselor spoke to the active roll they play in students school lives. Dr. Chomokos noted that there would be a 670 incoming freshman class for the upcoming school year, which was the enrollment year to-date

Principal Update

Principal Slover provided the following updates: 1) AZ Merit testing was well underway for middle school and winding down. She was very proud of the overall testing process this year. 2) Pre-K and Kindergarten enrollment was underway and for the 2017/2018 school year, Pre-K students would be required to re-enroll, unlike past years where they would automatically be enrolled into Kindergarten. 3) Class placement was underway.

She then spoke to a question regarding teacher placements for next year and also to the question about Common Core and if any changes would be made to our standards. She indicated that there would be no changes to our Common Core standards but only minor adjustments to the overall program. She also indicated that teacher placement was still in process and no definitive placements could be announced quite yet.

She then addressed the issue regarding teachers not having enough copy paper made available to them and she assured parents that copy paper was always available to teachers within a reasonable amount and she would be sure to remind teachers of this and have them send requests for paper to the front office for fulfillment.

Assistant Principal Updates

Mr. Patzlaff noted that the middle school student council will be in charge of the middle school talent show and auditions will be the week of May 1st and the show is scheduled for May 12th at 2pm and parents can attend.

Ms. DeFeyter noted that family movie night was scheduled for April 28th from 7pm to 9:30pm.

Communications Update

Ms. McCracken noted that the continued theme from concerned parents is "I didn't know about that". CRPTO continues to strive to provide better communication and one way of doing that is with the new BLAZE newsletter coming out weekly. In addition, Principal Slover will send a separate newsletter as needed. She reminded parents that Facebook, Twitter and Remind are available for communication options and parents are encouraged to utilize these channels.

Parent Concern

Ms. Parkhill informed attendees that on April 25th Scottsdale City Council will be voting to approve resolution No. 10770 authorizing the initiation of a Municipal Use Master Plan for the development of a 12.8+ acre DC Ranch park site, located between 91st street and Pima Road. She noted that if this project moves forward it will forever affect the face of DC Ranch. Great Hearts Academies, very powerful and politically connected Charter School is seeking land to be provided to them by the City for their own athletic facilities, instead of developing a park in perpetuity which is how the land was deeded in 2003 from DMB to City of Scottsdale. She encourage attendance at the upcoming City of Scottsdale Council Meeting on Tuesday, April 25 at 5 PM.
