Want To See More New Faces In Church In 2019?

How can we reach more people 2019? I read an article *Five Ways to Grow a Small Church* with these good tips for church growth (*excerpt*).

1. Set a growth target for your small church

You can't reach a goal if you don't set one. Be realistic. *Wouldn't you like to see 120-130 each Sunday morning? That's a realistic goal.

2. Increase the number personal invitations

The <u>invitation of a friend or family member</u> is still <u>the most effective form of adding people to your church</u>, so, invite people, including strangers that you meet.

3. Serve your church visitors/guests with honor

Your hospitality system plays a role in shaping a visitor's decision to return and get involved, remove the unnecessary barriers that keep visitors from making that second visit.

4. Be on a Mission in the community

I'm not talking about mission statements but rather the hands on work of <u>serving in the community</u> and being an agent of transformation in the community.

5. Pray

In John 15 there are two keys to effective prayer; **Abide** in an intimate relationship with Christ and **Ask** (Jesus invites us to ask). What is something measurable you can ask for? What is something specific that you can ask the Lord for with <u>regards to your evangelism efforts</u>? Prayer is key to church growth. This list is not exhaustive but these are action steps we are applying to grow our small church.
