Your attendance is not required, but highly encouraged as this is yet another event to recognize all you've accomplished during this unexpected and unprecedented year.

**Celebrate our Seniors!** The Parade of Seniors will take place on **Thursday, June 3rd**. We want the graduates to be celebrated and cheered as they have experienced a senior year of extremely unusual and unexpected circumstances. We encourage families to make signs and decorations and to honk, cheer and wave as the graduates pass by! Graduation is a HUGE deal and particularly so in the wake of all that our Seniors have endured this year and last year. They deserve to be celebrated for not only their hard work but resilience! With that in mind, we ask that all students and families act respectfully and responsibly so the parade remains a safe and wonderful experience for all!

**Parade Details:** Students are to arrive at **1:00 pm** on Juliet Drive; this is the street that runs alongside Casa's football field and there they may begin or add final touches to decorating their vehicles. Licensed Seniors may drive themselves or have a family member drive them. There will be only **one car per Senior** allowed in the parade. There should also be only one Senior per car unless they are a blood relative. There will be a clearly marked escort car parked at Juliet Drive. This is the car that students will line up behind and follow for the duration of the parade. The parade will begin at **2:00 pm**.

**Parade Route:** The escort car will depart from Juliet and turn Right onto Ely Blvd., Right onto Casa Grande Rd., Right onto McDowell Blvd., Right onto East Washington, Right onto Garfield, Left on Saint Augustine Circle and end at 2186 Saint Augustine Cir (see map). The streets will *not* be closed for the parade, so it is important that everyone be considerate, act respectfully, responsibly and abide by all traffic laws and rules of the road \*Passengers must remain inside the vehicle and absolutely no riding in truck beds. Those driving in the parade need to pay attention at all times! The escort car (and thus the parade), will be driving slowly and cautiously so all of the Seniors can be seen, acknowledged and of course remain safe.

## PARADE ROUTE



**Social Distancing and Safety Expectations:** All graduates and their families should remain inside their vehicles for the entirety of the parade. Family and friends who want to see the parade should refer to the map and park legally in parking lots or along the streets of the parade path. Those who choose to park and view the parade must use best social distancing practices; spread out along the parade path and not gather at one location. We have designed the parade with safety in mind and expect that Seniors and their families will abide by any current state orders on masking and social distancing. Be aware that this route will take the graduates through local neighborhoods and so respect and safety for these residents should always be your #1 priority.

**Additional:** A professional photographer will be available at the end of the route to capture the special moment the Senior crosses the finish line! Be sure to grab the information card from the photographer on how to access your photos for a small fee.
