

It had been three years since Jimmy Buffett & The Coral Reefer Band had come to Orange County, CA. That year in 2016, they were in town to close down the iconic Irvine Meadows Amphitheater. The Last Mango in Irvine concert was the last time The Orange County Parrot Head Club was able to host a parking lot party. Following the demolition of Irvine Meadows, many believed that Jimmy would not play in Orange County again. Everything changed when on National Margarita Day, an announcement was made that Jimmy and The Band was coming back to Orange County and playing in October at The Honda Center in Anaheim. The OCPHC knows how to host a party and this year was no exception. Parrot Heads from all over the country came to The Honda Center Parking Lot, which opened at 10:00 am for an 8:00 pm concert. The OCPHC RV was the center of the parking lot party. D.J. Dave Jensen opened the festivities with great Trop Rock music from Noon to 3pm. Alec Bauer took the stage and played the sea of parrot heads all the way to concert time. There is nothing like a parrot head parking lot party and we all can't wait until Jimmy and The Coral Reefers return to The OC!










## Escape To Margaritaville Returns in 2020







# Caroline Jones Releases Gulf Coast Girl With Help From Jimmy Buffett and a Few More Famous Friends

Singer, songwriter and musician Caroline Jones says ever since she began putting words to music at the age of 9, she knew exactly what she wanted to do in life. But it wasn't until the Connecticut native made a trip to Nashville that she realized the direction she wanted to take.

"I just fell in love with country music which I hadn't grown up listening to or been that familiar with, I fell in love with Hank Williams, Emmylou Harris, Dolly Parton, Willie Nelson, and Vince Gill." Caroline eventually met her manager and producer Ric Wake. (Wake produced Mariah Carey, Whitney Houston, Celine Dion, and Trisha Yearwood). Last year, Jones released her debut album called *Bare Feet*.

Along the way, she caught the attention of some well-known artists. Caroline has toured with Zac Brown, Jimmy Buffett, Kenny Chesney, and others.

Buffett says he first saw something special in Jones at a benefit concert in Tallahassee after Hurricane Irma wreaked havoc on Florida.

"I had heard good things about her from friends but was taken aback when I watched her open the show. Her stage presence and the care she took with an audience who basically didn't know who she was, was amazing to me."

"After the show, I thought we could give her a bit of boost and we asked her to open for our tour. Next thing you know, the Eagles wanted her on dates we were doing with them.

Buffett has not only been a strong supporter, he's now co-written a song for Jones.

"I became close friends with Jimmy when we went out on tour last year," she says. "I've known Mac McAnally since 2012. He's Jimmy's right hand man musically. So, it was a real honor when they came to me and said they'd written a song for me to sing called "Gulf Coast Girl."

Jones says the lyrics were written to speak to the beauty and culture of the Gulf Coast and Buffett took time to share some of that history with her. She does the lead vocals, but gets a little bit of help.

"The song features Jimmy, Kenny Chesney, it features Mac, and also features Lukas Nelson. It's an incredible group to be associated with or even named with in the same breath," she says.

Jones admits she loves and enjoys just about every aspect of the music business and is excited about all the future holds. She has a busy couple of months ahead. She's promoting her current single "Chasin' Me," will be touring with the Zac Brown Band, and says to look for more new music in the not-too-distant future.

"I'm just going to keep touring and making music and doing what I love. I'm so blessed to be doing it on a bigger and bigger scale all the time."

# American Songwriter Behind The Song Jimmy Buffett - The Peanut Butter Conspiracy

Imagine if you will, an episode from the *First-48* television show. Police in Hattiesburg, Mississippi are on the search for a serial shoplifting suspect. The crime? Stealing peanut butter and sardines from the local minimart. Detectives are on the hunt; can they solve this crime in the first 48 hours? Before I start putting this whole unorthodox sandwich of a story together for you, I'll go ahead and give you a clue. The suspect in this case was a young singer/songwriter named Jimmy Buffett, and the crime(s) took place in the late '60s. Luckily for Buffett, the statute of limitations has long expired, and he is no longer at risk of prosecution. Now back to the case.

What I have just described for you is the plot line of "Peanut Butter Conspiracy," a song on Buffett's 1973 album *A White Sport Coat and a Pink Crustacean*. The album, which was "technically" Buffett's 3rd album at the time, is often referred to as his 1st major release. Recorded in Nashville, the album is the first glimpse into Buffett's "Key West Phase" of music, however this particular song takes place far away from Key West, in the Mississippi town of Hattiesburg.

In his youth, Buffett spent time in "The Burg" as a student at the University of Southern Mississippi, where he was also a member of the Kappa Sigma fraternity. In his spare time between dodging class, chasing girls and learning how to play guitar, Buffett was a struggling musician, playing gigs anywhere he could find them between Hattiesburg and New Orleans. It was the '60s, the Vietnam war was in full tilt, and Buffett was trying to figure out what to do with his life. It's hard to imagine a poor and struggling Jimmy Buffett in modern times, but back then, this was exactly the case.

The song, written by Buffett himself, tells of being so broke at the time that he was forced to steal food on occasion to keep from going hungry. According to the song, he and his buddies swore to pay the Mini-Mart back if they ever got rich. Whether or not Buffett actually paid the Mini-Mart back is up for debate, but he often eludes to the idea that he made things right after finding success later in life.

As an alumnus of the same college and former customer of the Mini-Mart, I can personally verify the presence of sardines and peanut butter in current inventory, along with the addition of modern surveillance cameras, which seem to thwart the efforts of struggling songwriters and sticky fingers. Speaking of which, this album also hails the first appearance of Greg "Fingers" Taylor on harmonica, who would later become a career member of Buffett's band. How did Fingers join the band? Buffett met him in college and stole him from Hattiesburg too. Modern visitors to Hattiesburg can still see the original Kappa Sigma fraternity house on campus where Buffett lived. For enough Landshark Lager, the current residents might let you visit his old room. Peanut Butter and Sardines are optional but not required.




## Gypsies In The Palace by Chip Bell

# Wasted Away Again in Margaritaville...

### Margaritaville Island Resort to Open In San Diego





July 2019 - San Diego Business Journal: Mission Bay's Paradise Point Resort & Spa will be converted into a Margaritaville Island Resort – the first of its kind in the West Coast expected to open in 2020.

According to a news release, the property will undergo a \$35 million renovation that will feature 462 casita-style single-story guestrooms, various food & beverage concepts, and an update to the properties existing five pools, among other upgrades and amenities.

Davidson Hotels & Resorts, which currently operates Paradise Point Resort & Spa, will continue to manage Margaritaville once renovations are completed, according to the company.

"Our island resort offers a unique San Diego beach experience in a secluded, yet centrally situated location to nearby downtown San Diego, SeaWorld, Balboa Park, Seaport Village and other top attractions," said Jon E. Bortz, chairman, president and chief executive officer of Pebblebrook Hotel Trust, which acquired Paradise Point Resort & Spa in 2018. "Following an extensive evaluation of numerous alternatives, we selected Margaritaville because we believe it is the perfect fit for our San Diego Paradise Point Resort & Spa."

Margaritaville is inspired by the lyrics of singer/songwriter Jimmy Buffett, and features 18 locations, 24 projects in the works, two gaming properties and over 60 food and beverage venues around the country.

#### Sail On Paul Barrere



It is with great sorrow that Little Feat must announce the passing of our brother guitarist, Paul Barrere, this morning at UCLA Hospital. We ask for your kindest thoughts and best wishes to go out especially to his widow Pam and children Gabriel, Genevieve, and Gillian, and to all the fans who were his extended family.

Paul auditioned for Little Feat as a bassist when it was first being put together—in his words, "as a bassist I make an excellent guitarist"—and three years later joined the band in his proper role on guitar. Forty-seven years later, he was forced to miss the current tour, which will end tomorrow, due to side effects from his ongoing treatment for liver disease.

He promised to follow his doctor's orders, get back in shape, and rock on the beach at the band's annual gathering in Jamaica in January 2020. "Until then," he wrote, "keep your sailin' shoes close by...if I have my way, you're going to need them!"

As the song he sang so many times put it, he was always "Willin'," but it was not meant to be. Paul, sail on to the next place in your journey with our abiding love for a life always dedicated to the muse and the music. We are grateful for the time we have shared.
