- <u>AWIA Small Systems Resilience</u> This topic provides a refresh of the AWIA Deadlines and Requirements; introduces AWWA/RCAP Risk & Resiliency Resources for RRAs and ERPs; and equips small systems to be resilient to all hazards.
- Regulatory Overview Presented by Maryland Department of the Environment.
- <u>PFAS Contaminant of Concern</u> Attendees will achieve greater knowledge of PFAS/PFOA and associated health concerns; understand current regulations; identify proper sampling procedures; understand how to address the problem and identify resources for assistance.
- <u>Distribution System Infrastructure and Water Quality</u> Covers problems with common Distribution System components (piping, valves, storage tanks, and hydrants), and how they can drastically affect water quality, and public health. Provides preventive actions and solutions to common problems. Includes a deep dive on Water Main Flushing.
- <u>Coliform Sampling</u> Understand why coliform sampling is important for a public water system, and identify factors, conditions, and common issues that can lead to undesirable results when collecting samples
