WEEKLY THOUGHTS 10th SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME JUNE 9th 2024.

Dear friends, welcome to the 10th Sunday of Ordinary time preceded by the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus last Friday and the Immaculate Heart of Mary this Saturday. The Solemnities signify the divine love of God to mankind expressed by Jesus, and Mary his Mother, symbolized by the two hearts. Best wishes to all with a special devotion to the Sacred Heart and Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The Gospel Reading of this Sunday; Mark 3: 20-35 presents to us the unique teaching of Jesus on Family. Jesus had attracted many people who came to listen to his teaching as well as the miracles; healings he performed.

His relatives- family was upset and considered him insane. They wanted to get hold of him to save the family from embarrassment. Jesus went against the fear of backing away from preaching the good news.

Jesus gives us a new concept of the family. "These are my brothers, whoever does the will of God is brother, sister and mother to me." This is the bond of brotherhood under God the Father. It goes beyond the natural bond of the family, nationality and race. The Church is the family of God.

The Pharisees and religious leaders of the time considered Jesus as an enemy as well as his teaching and healing that was attributed to Beelzebub- the prince of demons.

Jesus' judgement on the experts of the law of being guilty of an eternal sin against the Holy Spirit; call it malicious attribution of the work of the Holy Spirit to an evil spirit. Thus, discrediting God's work leads to eternal damnation.

Our connection with Jesus gains us access to the Father and the Holy Spirit. Like Jesus, let us be focused on doing the will of his father despite the unreasonable family demands and expectations.
