## The Power of God for Salvation


Read Romans 1:1-17 and Ps 40

How do we show our power? Boys show power by flexing their muscles. Adults show power by buying nice homes, owning property, and padding their bank accounts. Jesus does not need to display His power as we do. Our God is powerful,, to be sure, but His great work of salvation comes to us by rather unremarkable means. Out of His love for us, He comes to save us in humble ways that only the eyes of faith can see as powerful. He comes to us through the Gospel.

#### **Praying for Our Nation**

From our nation's earliest days, God's promise in 2 Chronicles 7 that He will hear the cry of a humbled people has motivated American's leaders to call citizens to prayer. In 1775, as it began to process the forming a new nation, the Continental Congress called for a day of prayer. At critical junctures during the Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln called for the nation to fast and pray ( see page of newsletter). And in 1952, President Harry Truman signed a bill establishing an annual *National Day of Prayer* (see page of newsletter).

Second Chronicles helps establish a model of national spiritual renewal. The book recounts how a succession of righteous kings in Judah led to reforms that brought the people back to true faith in God. Second Chronicles 16:9 assures us that God will show Himself strong" toward those who place their trust in Him.

## GOD AND STATE CONSTITUTIONS (We are a Christian Nation—NOT a Muslim Nation)

While there have been revisions to state constitutions over the years, forth-three state constitutions acknowledge God or a higher power in their preambles (introductory clause of explanation), and the other states acknowledge God in their religious freedom provision.

Connecticut 1818, Preamble: "The people of Connecticut acknowledging with gratitude the good providence of God in permitting them to enjoy a free government...."

Maine 1820, Preamble: "We the People of Maine ... acknowledge with gratitude hearts the goodness of the Sovereign Ruler of the Universe in affording us an opportunity .... and employing Hid aid and direction in the accomplishment...."

Massachusetts 1789, Preamble: "We, therefore, the people of Massachusetts, acknowledging with grateful hearts, the goodness of the Great Legislator of the Universe, in affording us, in the course of His Providence, an opportunity.... and devoutly imploring His direction...."

New York 1846, Preamble: "We, the people of the State of New York, grateful to Almighty God for our freedom, in order to secure its blessings...."

*North Carolina, Preamble:* Through its history, North Carolina has had three Constitutions: the Constitution of 1776, the Constitution of 1868, and the Constitution of 1971.

The Preamble and Constitution of 1776:

*Preamble:* "We, the people of the State of North Carolina, grateful to Almighty God, the Sovereign Ruler of Nations, for the preservation of the American Union and the existence of our civil, political and religious liberties, and acknowledging our dependence upon Him for the continuance of those blessings to us and our posterity....."

Constitution: Article XIX. That all men have a natural and unalienable right to worship Almighty God according to the dictates of their own consciences.

The Constitution of 1868, and 1971: It seems like the Preamble did not change

Second Constitution of 1868: Changed the North Carolina government drastically was adopted. For the first time, all major state officers were elected by the people Article I: Declaration of Rights Sec. 26 All persons have a natural and inalienable right to worship Almighty God according to the dictates of their own consciences, and no human authority shall, in any case whatever, control or interfere with the rights of conscience..

Third Constitution of 1971: Article I: Declaration of Rights Sec. 13. Religious liberty. All persons have a natural and inalienable right to worship Almighty God according to the dictates of their own consciences, and no human authority shall, in any case whatever, control or interfere with the rights of conscience.

# The Amusing Cucumber (I'm back)

# The Doctrine of the Assumption of the Mary

August 15: The Assumption is a doctrine that teaches that the Blessed Virgin Mary had been taken up, body and soul, into heaven. This process is called "translation" in the Bible and there are two notable examples in the scripture, Enoch (Hebrews 11:5) and Elijah (2 Kings 2:11). At the Council of Chalcedon in A.D. 451, when bishops from throughout the Mediterranean met in Constantinople, Emperor Marcian asked the Patriarch of Jerusalem to bring the relics of Mary to Constantinople to be enshrined in the capitol. The patriarch explained to the emperor that there were no relics of Mary in Jerusalem, that "Mary had died in the presence of the apostles; but her tomb, when opened later . . . was found empty and so the apostles concluded that the body was taken up into heaven." There is no scriptural evidence to support or deny this doctrine as applied to Mary.

### The Jewish State. 1945

According to Margaret Truman, the most difficult decision Harry S. Truman faced as president was whether to support the creation of a Jewish homeland in Palestine after World War II. "I am trying to .... Make the whole world safe for Jews," he wrote. In November 1947, he lobbied for the United Nations' resolution that divided Palestine into Jewish and Arab states

Great Britain announced it would transfer its authority over Palestine to the United Nations by May 14, 1948. On the eve of British withdrawal, most American experts strongly opposed the creation of a Jewish state, warning Truman that Arab countries would cut off oil and unite to destroy the Jews. But Truman weighed the multifaceted concerns and held firm.

The nation's first prime minister, David Ben-Gurion, read a declaration of Jewish independence. "The name of our state shall be Israel." At midnight, British rule over Palestine lapsed; eleven minutes later, White House spokesman Charlie Ross announced U.S. recognition. The American statement recognizing the new State of Israel bears President Truman's last minute handwritten changes. "With Truman's decision, the hopes of the Jewish people were realized."

The Lord builds up Jerusalem; He gathers together the outcast of Israel. He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.— Psalm 147:2-3



### A Stewardship Minute

Tithing is a spiritual adventure. It is but the beginning of a deeper, richer relationship with God. The time to launch out is now. Is that an adventure we want? Listen to this true story and then consider the challenge.

A pastor preached a sermon on the benefits of tithing and a couple of years later retired to another city. One day he received a package from a parishioner who had heard the sermon and simply could not forget what the pastor had said. When he opened the package, he found two lovely framed pictures, both of a carved wooden angel attached to the end of a pew in the chancel area where choir members sat during worship. The choir pews were on opposite sides of

the chancel facing each other, thus the angels faced one another. One angel was facing left in the frame and the other angel faced right as though they were looking at each other. The pastor wondered exactly why his former parishioner had gone to the trouble of taking those pictures and sending them to him. The man had composed a letter that explained:

> "Dear Pastor, before you retired you gave a sermon on tithing. This gave me the courage to start. At the time I was out of work. I started tithing my unemployment checks. Not long after starting to tithe, I got a job and have been employed

ever since. So thanks again for giving me the gift of the tithe. Please consider the photos as a gift in return."

Those pictures are now hanging on a wall in the pastor's home. He considers them among the loveliest gifts he has ever received. The pastor often shows them to visitors and lets them read the letter written by a grateful parishioner. Tithing is, indeed, a spiritual adventure; the beginning of a deeper, richer relationship with God!

## August 7th

#### HISTORY OF PURPLE HEART DAY

The original Purple Heart, designated as a Badge of Merit, was awarded by George Washington in 1782. There was a lack of funds in the Continental Army at the time so the award was a way to honor enlisted and deserving people. The honor is presented to soldiers for "any singularly meritorious action." It was designed with a piece of silk bound through it with a thin edge of silver. Washington only gave out three of the badges himself, and instead authorized subordinates to issue the badges as they saw fit.

The Badge of Merit faded from use but was revived and relaunched in 1932, this time as the Purple Heart. As well as honoring those wounded in combat, this iteration of the Purple Heart recognized commendable action. It was in 1944 that the policy was tweaked slightly and the Purple Heart was given the purpose we know it for today, specifically to honor those who have been wounded or died.

The first service member to be given the modern Purple Heart was General Douglas MacArthur for his service in the Pacific theater during World War II. In total there have been 1.8 million Purple Hearts awarded over the years.

Purple Heart Day was first observed in 2014 and has been observed every year since. It's a chance to reflect on the bravery of those who have fought for the U.S. and to ensure that their courage is never forgotten.

Thought this was pretty amazing and interesting!

For all the scientists out there, and for all the students who have a hard time convincing these people regarding the truth of the Bible, here's something that shows God's awesome creation, and that He is still in control.

Did you know that the space program is busy proving that what has been called "myth" in the Bible is true?

Mr. Harold Hill, President of the Curtis Engine Company in Baltimore, Maryland, and a consultant in the space program, relates the following development. "I think one of the most amazing things that God has done for us today happened recently to our astronauts and space scientists at Green Belt, Maryland ..."

They were checking out where the positions of the sun, moon, and planets would be 100 years and 1,000 years from now. We have to know this so we won't send up a satellite and have it bump into something later on in its orbits. We have to lay out the orbits in terms of the life of the satellite and where the planets will be so the whole thing will not bog down.

They ran the computer measurement back and forth over the centuries, and it came to a halt. The computer stopped and put up a red signal, which meant that there was something wrong with either the information fed into it or with the results as compared to the standards. They called in the service department to check it out, and they said, "What's wrong?" Well, they found there is a day missing in space in elapsed time. They scratched their heads and tore their hair out. There was no answer.

Finally a Christian man on the team said, "You know, one time I was in Sunday School, and they talked about the sun standing still." While they didn't believe him, they didn't have an answer either, so they said, "Show us, "

He got a Bible and went to the book of Joshua where they found a pretty ridiculous statement for any one with "common sense." There they found the Lord saying to Joshua, "Fear them not, I have delivered them into thy hand; there shall not a man of them stand before Thee." Joshua was concerned because he was surrounded by the enemy! And if darkness fell, they would overpower them. So Joshua asked the Lord to make the sun stand still! That's right.... "The sun stood still and the moon stayed and lasted not to go down about a whole day!" (Joshua 10:12-13)

The astronauts and scientists said, there is the missing day! They checked the computers going back into the time it was written and found it was close but not close enough. The elapsed time that was missing back in Joshua's day was 23 hours and 20 minutes .. Not a whole day. They read the Bible, and there it was about [approximately] a day.. These little words in the Bible are important, but they were still in trouble because if you cannot account for 40 minutes, you'll still be in trouble 1000 years from now. Forty minutes had to be found because it can be multiplied many times over in orbits. As the Christian employee thought about it, he remembered somewhere in the Bible where it said the sun went BACKWARDS.

The scientists told him he was out of his mind, but they got out the Book and read these words in 2 Kings that told of the following story: Hezekiah, on his death bed, was visited by the prophet Isaiah who told him that he was not going to die. Hezekiah asked for a sign as proof. Isaiah said "Do you want the sun to go ahead 10 degrees?"

Hezekiah said, "It is nothing for the sun to go ahead 10 degrees, but let the shadow return backward 10 degrees. Isaiah spoke to the Lord, and the Lord brought the shadow ten degrees BACKWARD! Ten degrees is exactly 40 minutes!"

Twenty-three hours and 20 minutes in Joshua, plus 40 minutes in Second Kings make the missing day in the universe! Isn't it amazing?

#### HEAT SAFETY TIPS

Heat is the top weather related killer, causing more fatalities than lightning, tornadoes, and hurricanes combined. To practice heat safety, review this checklist.

#### **Drink More Fluids**

- Drink more fluids, regardless of your activity level. Don't wait until you're thirsty to drink. Bring a renewable water bottle with you to maintain hydration. If you're at work, you could bring a drinking glass and a pitcher and fill it every morning.
- If you're old, be especially careful to drink fluids because the amount of water retained by the body decreases with age.
- Avoid salt tables, if possible. If your doctor has you on water pills, ask him/her how much you should drink.
- Don't drink liquids with dehydrating caffeine, alcohol, or large amounts of sugar. Avoid very cold drinks.
- At family events and reuions, bring a cooler of cool drinks.
- Cut back on exercising on hot days. If you must exercise, drink two to four glasses of cool, non alcoholic fluids each hour.

#### **Keep Your Body Cool**

- Dress in lightweight, light colored clothing and sun-reflecting shirts.
- Wear loose clothing. Wear wide-brimmed hats and sunglasses. Keep a stash of has on hand for friends and family!
- According to the Center for Disease Control and Preventions (CDC), fans may provide comfort, but they do not prevent heatrelated illnesses when the temperature is in the high 90s. Take a cool shower bath or more to an air-conditioned place to
  cool off.
- Stay in the shade, especially between 11 AM and 3 PM.
- Avoid strenuous activities during the heat of the day.
- Never leave anyone in a parked vehicle with windows closed or open.
- To feel cooler, eat cooler. Reduce your protein intake.
- Open your house to the breeze after sunset and leave it open until dawn.
- In the early morning, drew the shades before the temperature starts to rise.

#### Protect Yourself From the Sun.

- Don't get too much sun. Sunburn makes it difficult for your body to dissipate heat.
- In addition to a hat and sunglasses, wear sunscreen od SPF 15 or higher. The most effective products say "broad spectrum" or UVA/UVB" on the label.

#### Stay Alert

- Be aware of heavy sweating hot and dry skin, rapid pulse, pale or clammy skin, and/or cramps in your leg or abdomen muscles. All could be sign of heat disorder.
- If you are older, it's wise to keep medical information readily available, including phone numbers of health care providers and copies of your prescription and health insurance cards.

The Declaration of Independence declared not only the colonies' independence from Britain, but also a dependence on "the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God." These had been defined by historic legal writers, such as Sir William Blackstone, as the laws that God had established for the governance of people, nations, and nature. Blackstone's Commentaries on the Law, the primary law book of the Founding Fathers, defined "the laws of nature" as the will of God for man.

Man, considered as a creature, must necessarily be subject to the laws of his Creator; for he is entirely a dependent being....It is necessary that he should in all points conform to his Maker's will. This will of his Maker is called the law of nature....It is binding over all the globe, in all countries, and at all times; no human laws are of any validity, if contrary to this... But every man now finds that his reason is corrupt, and his understanding full of ignorance and error....The doctrines thus delivered we call the revealed or divine law, and they are to be found only in the Holy Scriptures. Upon these two foundations....no human laws should be suffered to contradict these. Sir William Blackstone

## **Our History**

Roe vs. Wade in 1973 had gone unanswered in Gaston County, until on November 13, 1985, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. an initial meeting of the Board of Directors was held at the law offices of Cherry, Bekaert, & Holland here in Gastonia.

Seven men and women came together as God had encouraged their hearts to respond compassionately to the needs of those facing unplanned pregnancies. They gathered to initiate a ministry that would upon opening their doors for clients in September of 1986 have an immediate impact.

- No longer would words be heard without matching deeds and actions that gave a visible expression of our concern for the abortion issue.
- No longer would someone who could not afford a pregnancy test be denied one.
- No longer would the longing for a listening ear, a compassionate, caring counselor when the crisis of pregnancy came about be denied.
- No longer would the everyday needs of material assistance and crisis calls from clients of needing a listening ear, go unanswered.

On that day, this Board of Directors, composed of Dale Chase, Rev. Marion Clark, Audrue McMahan, David Ward, Rev. Marlin Mull, Peter Caprise, Rachel Pichet and Cathy Epperson nominated officers, set meeting times, elected an Executive Director, and voted to request information from a sister CPC. Other Board members unable to attend that day were: Steve Baker, Laura C. Atkins, Rev. M.O. Owens, Dr. Glenn Phoenix and Dr. Thomas Will.

From that humble beginning, the Crisis Pregnancy Center of Gaston County has been in three pivotal rental locations and finally was able to purchase property and a home in July 1996. The journey from those initial days included leadership from diversely skilled Board of Director Members, to Executive Directors, to multi-talented staff, to service by Volunteers that utilized the gifts of individuals as well as the strengths of an interdenominational ecumenical corporate body working for the cause of the unborn.

The history of the Crisis Pregnancy Center of Gaston County, Inc. has included immeasurable faith, the development of a support base that transcends race, gender and religion. The experience of serving in this setting allows women, men and their families to see the efforts of all combined to meet the needs of one. It is an awesome testimony to see so many varied agencies, individuals, and churches tackling this single issue.

From its inception, the Crisis Pregnancy Center of Gaston County, Inc. has now served 50,000+ clients, been blessed by faithful volunteers, trusted God for budget needs numerous times, and made an impact in this County that is now indelible and indispensable.

Over the years, an expanding staff, a diversified Board, Abstinence emphasis, ultrasound/medical clinic, seasoned and well trained volunteers, public presentations, our annual fund-raisers, ad. infitnitum, are making the future as bright as God's genius and calling.


