#### COSA's Development Services Re-inspection Fee Process Changes

Currently, re-inspection fees are assessed by the City of San Antonio's Development Services inspectors when your project fails inspection for one or more of the following reasons:

- Work not ready for inspection
- Code deficiencies
- Corrections from a previous inspection are not made
- Work covered with earth, concrete, sheetrock, plaster, insulation, building finishes, etc.
- · City reviewed plans not on the job site when required
- No access to equipment/inspection
- Building/house locked
- Gate codes not provided
- Unable to locate building due to address not being posted

When assessing these fees, the inspector is required to open several computer screens before entering the required fee. These burdensome, time-consuming steps slow down the inspection process; therefore, the inspectors are not as efficient when responding to their assigned inspections for the day. This time drain may actually result in some of the inspections not

being performed for the day they were scheduled.

Beginning Monday, August 13, 2007, re-inspection fees will be automatically assessed on your permit by the Hansen Land Development software system whenever an inspector disapproves a scheduled inspection for one of the above listed reasons. Exception: When an inspector arrives at the job site on the day <u>after</u> the inspection was scheduled to be performed, the re-inspection fee <u>will not be assessed</u>.)

In other cases where there are extenuating circumstances, re-inspection fees may only be waived by either the Senior Inspector or the Chief Inspector for that discipline. All waivers will be documented properly in the Hansen system for audit purposes.
