TOOLS REQUIRED

Phillips screwdriver 7/16" wrench

ADJUSTMENT OF SHELVES

According to the needs of customers, shelves can be dismantled through screws to store more guns.



BARREL REST INSTALLATION

Install Barrel Rests using a Phillips screw driver with provided screws and barrel rests.

Install Barrel Rests based upon your model configuration included in the parts instruction and by the associated drawings.

According to the needs of customers, barrel rest can be dismantled through screws to store more items.





SELECTING A LOCATION

The cabinet must be mounted to wall studs or the floor. For optimal safety and security, the cabinet should be installed adjacent to the side wall of a closet with minimal space on either side of the cabinet, in an isolated, dry and secure area. The cabinet should be flat against the wall at the back of the unit, as well as flat on the floor. Remove the baseboard if necessary.



A WARNING

THE CABINET SHOULD ALWAYS BE KEPT OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

SECURING THE CABINET

- 1. Open gun cabinet and mark the predrilled holes with a pencil on the back or bottom.
- 2. Drill 10 mm holes with 10mm drill bit.
- 3. Put the expansion bolts in to the holes.
- 4. Move the gun cabinet in place, align it over the hole.
- 5. Secure the gun cabinet with the nut.

NOTE: This cabinet must be mounted to wall studs or the floor. Failure to do so will compromise the safety and security of the cabinet. Consult your hardware retailer for fastening hardware for your particular mounting surfaces.
