

ATTENTION Re: Puget Sound Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS)

Sailing vessels and craft less than 65ft in length shall **NOT IMPEDE** and shall **STAY CLEAR** of large vessels to ensure safe navigation.

FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF with and **FOLLOW** the **Navigation Rules. Rule 10** applies to TSS.

Scan for Code of Federal Regulations § 83.10 Traffic Separation Schemes (Rule 10)



- ✓ Avoid the TSS when not using
- ✓ The size and speed of large ships can be deceiving
- ✓ Large ships may have a hard time seeing you
- ✓ Wakes from large ships can be hazardous
