

DOI to offer remote proctored exams

BOISE, ID – The Idaho Department of Insurance (DOI) will offer remote proctored exams for insurance licensing beginning December 16, 2020.

While on-site testing facilities remain an option for candidates, PSI remote proctored exams will be offered starting December 16th in order to expand testing options to accommodate the needs of Idahoans seeking insurance licenses. The online program provides a robust, secure system for Idaho candidates, connecting them directly with a live proctor who monitors the examination process.

“We are pleased to offer remote proctored exams for Idahoans in the insurance industry through the PSI program,” said Director Dean Cameron. “Offering remote testing options in addition to our traditional on-site testing facilities is important, especially during unique times like we’ve experienced this year with Covid.”

The PSI program helps us to accommodate a wider range of candidates in the industry while maintaining the same rigorous standards.
