

ALL-YOU-CAN-EAT PANCAKE MEAL - HIGH SCHOOL CAFETERIA (7 AM - 2 PM) & MASONIC LODGE (9 AM - 3 PM): Adults - \$8; Children 5-12 - \$6; 4 & Under are Free.

1861 BUILDING - Now the Marathon Area Historical Society's Museum - filled with exhibits; lots of opportunities to chat with area folks!! Celebrating today's youth who have made recent history!

AMERICAN LEGION: Hop on a shuttle bus and enjoy the cake wheel, raffles, face painting & crafts. Food - pancake breakfast, French fries, hot sausage, burgers, hot dogs, chili, coffee, hot chocolate.

BAPTIST CHURCH GYM: (10 AM-Noon, both days) - Saturday: "Dan the Snake Man," bounce house, family Bible display, Christian Academy Students' displays. Sunday (in the Sanctuary), music for reflection & worship; Gym has maple message, "Dan the Snake Man," exhibits, and (from 1-2 p.m.) meet the NYS Maple Queen.

CIVIC BUILDING: Juried crafts (listed below); Maple Leaf Senior Center. Food - Maple milk shakes; muffins, lemonade, tea (iced or hot), hot coffee and maple chocolate, sweet & salty maple pretzel rods, bottled water, sap bucket raffle.

FIRE STATION: NY State Police.
