Let's all work together to make one last push towards reaching our goal of blessing the **Texas Baptist Home for Children** with funds to help with their swimming pool repairs. No offering is too small because every dollar adds up and counts towards our goal of \$12,500. Their repairs will be more than \$30,000. The pool is available to all the Children's home families and staff. It is used as a ministry tool as they provide a safe fun environment for the children in foster care. Let us continue to pray for this ministry.

As of October 20, 2019, we had received \$13,771 for our project total. Most of that amount will go to the **TBHC**, \$12,497 while \$637 is split between our general fund and our youth fund. We have met our goal, but the swimming pool repairs are more than that, so let's not quit yet! Let's keep going and far exceed our goal!

We had 2 retreats this year with opportunities to raise funds for our project. In the spring we meet with Northside, Conroe where we received a great offering and sold many shirts.

During our fall retreat in Gilmer, with held a "Pound in a Purse" Auction which brought in \$1859. Ladies took home purses for as low as \$12 -\$15 while others paid as much as \$80, with one lady taking home 5 purses! Curiosity lead us to find out what was in the purses. We found honey, a pound cake, craft supplies, bath goodies, cake making supplies, \$20 bill, coffee, and lots more goodies.
